PCAV State Rule for Composite Teams

- Composite Teams for Games, Flat and Musical (which is at the Zone Representatives discretion).
 Teams must meet the criteria for age groups and eligibility; members of each team must be from the same Zone.
- The Midland Zone allows clubs to form Composite Teams thus encouraging riders to join in and have a go. Composite Teams that meet the rider eligibility guidelines can compete for placings. If a Composite Team qualifies for State they may be eligible to compete at the Zone Reps discretion. The Composite Team is not eligible to win the Cyril Martin Perpetual Trophy. This Trophy can only be won by the highest placing Club Team.

NON-COMPETITIVE CLUB TEAMS

A club may make up a non-competitive team. The team may consist of riders being assisted, and excess riders in a higher age group. These teams will compete in a competition against other clubs riding "NOT TO SCORE".

DISCLAIMER

Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the Midland Zone accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.

ELIGIBILITY

PCAV Club Member Cards must be presented at Zone Qualifier to ensure eligibility is proven in accordance with the PCAV Handbook of By-Laws 2016.

'C' Certificates – Riders who have been in pony club for more than two years and are aged over 13 years (have passed their 14th birthday by the day of the championships) must have attained their 'C' Certificate in order to compete at the State Championships in accordance with criteria for State events in the PCAV Handbook of By-laws.

Flat or Pairs or Musical or Games – Eligible combinations may compete in <u>all or any</u> of the flat competitions (Flat Teams and/or Musical Ride) <u>and/or</u> the Kay Irving Memorial Games in the same year.

GEAR RULES

- Strictly in accordance with the PCAV Gear Rules book 2016. Also refer to specific sections in the gear rules for Flat Teams, Musical Ride and Games.
- Gear check is required once before the Flat Tests, Musical Ride and Games program begins.
- All team members must present to gear check with their Team Manager.
- For games no helmet covers, other than the one supplied by the Organising Committee are to be worn.
- Each Flat Team is responsible for providing their own back numbers 1 to 4.
- Letters for Games Teams will be provided on the day by the Organising Committee. Team Managers must collect letters in sets of seven.

HORSE RESTRICTIONS

- 1. The horse must be at least 4 years of age for Mounted Games.
- 2. Any horse which is lame, or becomes lame, will be excluded from the competition
- 3. Height/weight ratio of riders and mount are to be assessed by the Zone Representatives

SCORING – as per the PCAV Schedule

AWARDS

Flat Ride - "Nelson Memorial Perpetual Trophy" - sashes 1st to 6th place.

Musical Ride – "Betty Klingenberg/Rosemary Harris Perpetual Trophy" – sashes 1st to 6th place.

Games Team - "Cyril Martin Perpetual Trophy" - sashes 1st to 6th place.

Pairs Team – sashes 1st to 6th place

Presentations – Flat & Musical Ride presentations will be made unmounted. Games Team presentations will be done mounted, all riders must present wearing full pony club uniform.

RULES FOR 2016:

- By-law 24 Fall of Rider and further participation in competition/activity.
 - 24.1 Fall of Rider For all competitions and activities, including the practice and warm up areas, the first fall of rider is to be categorised and actions applied as indicated using the following scale of severity.
 - For Games Teams, Flat Teams and Musical Ride Teams competitions Should a rider fall, remount
 and complete the game or continue in the ride they must be checked by the medical personnel
 responsible for the event and have a Fall Release Form signed before taking further part in the
 competition.
 - Leaving the arena in any Flat ride Riders will not be eliminated; they should keep going and the
 offending rider to catch up.
 - Team Leaders only, have permission to talk during the ride (limited amount of talking).
 - Fall of Rider in the Flat or Musical this will incur a penalty of 12 points, 6 points per Judge. The
 music for the Musical Ride will not be stopped; the ride is to continue when the fallen rider has
 remounted. If the Judges deem the fall of the rider to be severe the Team will be eliminated.

Composition of Games Teams

- Club Teams may comprise six or seven combinations that meet eligibility rules.
 Two shall be in the Black Groups, two in the Green Group, and two or three in the Red Group.
 - Group. I. Black Group 25 Years of Age or under (on the day of the State Finals)
 II. Green Group Under 19 Years of Age (on the day of the State Finals)

 NOTE CHANGE TO AGE FOR GREEN GROUP
 - III. Red Group Under 14 Years of Age (on the day of the State Finals)
- Teams which qualify at Zone level with six riders may include a 7th rider in accordance with the PCAV rules.
- The Team Manager may select any six combinations for any event on the day ensuring there is no more than 2 Black or 2 Green riders on the field at any time.
- The selected combinations may compete in any order in each event

- Dismantle the flat rings & set up the games events (all Clubs expected to help)
- Pack up at the end of the day (all Clubs expected to help)

Clubs will be allocated jobs on the day and it will be their responsibility to ensure they have a person allocated to this job.

Equipment

Needed for the games (5 Lanes)

- 10 x 200 ltr open drums
- 35 flags (1.37 m x20cm dowelling)
- 5 Batons (450mmx20mm Dowell)
- 30 blocks for the flags
- 10 x Mugs
- ❖ 10 x 70cm cones
- 10 tennis balls
- ❖ 5 x 15lt Flexi Tubs
- 35 x Socks (rolled up and sewn together to give a finished diameter of 8 cm)
- ❖ 5 x 900mm x20mm Wooden Dowelling
- ❖ 60 150mm pieces of Wood cut square on edges 100mm x 50 mm.
