- 1984** Gained NCAA Division I status
- 1987** Captured Great West Hockey Conference title
- 1988** Nissan/Jeep Classic champion
- 1990** Earned first NCAA Championship berth (finished 21-11-2)
- 1991** NCAA Championship qualifier, swept Boston College in first round (finished 22-17-4)
- 1992** School-record 27 wins, earned NCAA Championship berth
