Financial Obligations

All Show Choir Members (Singers, Band, & Roadies) are required to pay a \$60 Activity Fee to Millard West High School in order to participate in extra-curricular school activities. Please pay this fee to Millard West during Fall Registration.

Millard West will be charging \$450 for costumes & travel this year. This money will be used for uniform and supply needs, as well as hotel costs for the March Competition. Covered with this expense: Girls – shoes, tights, dress, spankies, jewelry, make-up, leotard, and possible costume change. Boys – shoes, suit, shirt, tie, and possible costume change. Members will not receive uniforms until paid in full. The payment schedule is as follows:

Students may purchase extra shoes, tights, make-up, ties, and shirts at their own expense.

Band Members & Roadies will not be charged a costume fee. Roadies will be provided a costume and band members will be asked to wear performance black for shows. There is a small possibility that band members could also be asked to wear matching ties and/or scarves, if that is the case we will collect a small fee next fall, not to exceed \$20.

If Show Choir is a financial hardship, please visit with the accounting office at MWHS. There are options to help, and they would keep your situation confidential.

Possible Additional Expenses

Students usually purchase T-Shirts and Sweats for competitions. This is not a requirement. Additional expenses could include: food/drink/souvenirs at competitions, show choir camps attended during the summer, extra costume pieces, etc. All of the above expenses are not covered by the school.

Bonding - Mandatory

Every year the show choirs (Singers, Band members, & Roadies) go on an outing to meet each other and plan our year. The date for bonding is on **August 2, 2013.** More details to follow at the May 29th meeting.

Costumes

It is the responsibility of show choir members to take care of their costumes. Our costumes are one of a kind and very delicate. Please take your costume out of the garment bag to air out, and follow all cleaning instructions given to us by our costumer. Be Very Careful if you choose to clean your costume!! If you lose or ruin a piece of your costume you will not be able to perform until your costume piece is replaced at your expense.

Appearance

Appearance is vitally important to our success and needs to have uniformity. This includes competitions as well as non-judged performances. Stage appearance is non-negotiable.

- Natural Hair color only.
- Men Hair off the collar, ears, and eyebrows. Clean shaven.
- Women Hair out of face, and styled as determined by the directors.
- No piercings or tattoos visible during performances. Only uniformed costume jewelry will be allowed during performances.
- All make-up will be uniform and determined by the directors.

Show Choir Expectations

Students are expected to follow the following three guidelines to be in show choir.

Reliable – You are on time to all rehearsals & performances (3 unexcused absences may result in dismissal from group). You will be enrolled in choir for the full academic year. You will help with any necessary set-up, tear-down, loading, un-loading, clean-up, etc. You will maintain passing grades in order to remain performance eligible in accordance with NSAA policy. You will abstain from Drug/Alcohol use and any other illegal activity. In short, your teammates, directors, and school can rely on you.

Respectful – You will show respect to all directors, teammates, volunteers, school, opposing schools, etc. You will bring a positive attitude every day. You will keep show choir drama-free.

Maximum Effort – You will put forth your best effort in each and every rehearsal, performance, and choral event.
