SECOND AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT FOR SPECIAL INSPECTIONS AND CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL TESTING SERVICES FOR THE FIRE STATION 9 PROJECT

This contract amendment ("Amendment No. 2") is dated and entered into as of the

BACKGROUND.

The City and the Contractor entered into a contract titled "Contract for Special Inspections and Construction Material Testing Services for the Fire Station 9 Project" dated December 19, 2012. That contract is referred to as the "Original Contract." The Original Contract provided that the Owner would pay the Contractor a not to exceed amount of \$30,000.00 for Services and Scope to be Performed, as set forth in the Original Contract.

By an instrument titled "Amendment to Contract for Special Inspections and Construction Material Testing Services for the Fire Station 9 Project" dated January 16, 2014 ("Amendment 1"), the Original Contract was amended to add additional construction material testing and special inspection to the Project, as detailed in Exhibit E, and increasing the total compensation for services to the lump sum amount of \$50,000.00.

The parties intend by this Amendment to acknowledge that the Contractor is required to perform additional services and scope. The Contract is hereby further amended as follows:

- 1. Sec. 2. <u>Services and Scope to be Performed</u> is amended by adding the following to the end of the section:
 - A1 Consulting Group, Inc. shall also provide those services specified in Exhibit D, entitled "Exhibit D Additional Supplemental Services" dated April 10, 2014.
- 2. Sec. 4 . <u>Contractor's Billings to City. Compensation</u> is amended by adding the following to the end of the section:

This Amendment will increase the amount specified in Sec. 4 by \$39,750.00 to the revised not-to-exceed contract amount t of \$89,750.00. Compensation for this Amendment is outlined in Exhibit D. All compensation is based on time and materials fees as stated in Exhibit A, entitled "Exhibit A – Schedule of Fees for Fire Station 9" and referred to in the Original Contract.

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- 3. Sec. 8. <u>Attachments</u> is amended by adding the following to the end of the Section: Exhibit D, "Exhibit D Additional Supplemental Services" dated April 10, 2014, consisting of 1 page, is hereby incorporated by reference.
- 4. Subparagraph 12.7.16 shall be added as follows:

E-Verify Compliance. The contractor represents and covenants that the contractor and its subcontractors comply with the requirements of Article 2 of Chapter 64 of the North Carolina General Statutes (NCGS). The City is relying on this E-Verify Compliance section in entering into this contract. The parties agree to this section only to the extent authorized by law. If this section is held to be unenforceable or invalid in whole or in part, it shall be deemed amended to the extent necessary to make this contract comply with NCGS 160A-20.1(b).

5. Except as otherwise changed or altered by this Contract Amendment, the terms and conditions of the Original Contract, as amended, shall remain in effect and are incorporated herein.
