- Advisement
  - Run your LoboTrax Audit from LoboWeb to assist you in planning your class schedule for next semester
  - Make sure your major and minor (if applicable) are declared with your advisor
  - Create a proposed schedule to review during your advisement session by using [degrees.unm.edu](http://degrees.unm.edu)
  - Visit with your advisor to review courses for the following semester and to have your hold removed prior to your registration date.
  - Review your intended major's graduation requirements. Some majors may require internships, service projects, research projects, etc. to graduate.
