This year is going to be an exciting time and we are ready to get started

Before you arrive there are a few things you need to know...

- HEADLINERS CAMP, AGES 9-18 BEGINS MONDAY, JUNE 13 AT 8:30 AM
- STARS OF TOMORROW CAMP, AGES 4-8 BEGINS MONDAY, JUNE 6 AT 9:00 AM
- Snacks will be provided every day of camp. If campers choose to bring their own snacks they
 must be turned in with their name on it at the Call Board located in the lobby.
- Lunch (HEADLINERS ONLY, age's 9-18) will be each camper's responsibility; Refrigeration and microwave are not available. On arrival, lunches should be dropped off with their name on it at the Call Board located in the lobby. Campers will not be allowed to leave for lunch. And please no takeout food. The campers schedule is very tight. Food is not allowed in classrooms.
- Wear loose and comfortable clothes that are easy to move in. Tennis shoes or dance shoes will be the best choice of footwear for camp. No flip flops or sandals and pull back long hair.
- Drop-off and pick-up of all campers will be through the STAGE DOOR located at the back of the Welder Center. To access this door, enter the parking lot off of Liberty Street and exit through the parking lot on to Forrest St. This drop-off/pick-up location is much safer than Main Street. Once inside the building, campers sign in at the Call Board located in the lobby. Note: All campers leaving early must be checked out with their parent/guardian at the Welder Center Box Office.
 Parking in the back lot will not be permitted between the hours of 8:00 am 5:00 pm.
- T3 Olympics (HEADLINERS ONLY, age's 9-18) will be held on Saturday, June 18 at 11:00 AM. This year we will all be inside the Welder Center in the AC. Groups will vie for the coveted "T3 Olympic Goblet". The Family is welcome and encouraged to join the campers and staff at the T3 Games. Also, guests will be able to get a sneak peak from the upcoming camp shows as our campers will perform.
- "On the Boards" (STARS OF TOMORROW ONLY, age's 4-8) the final presentation for family and friends will let everyone know what the campers have been up to. It will be Friday, June 10TH at 11:30 am. No Ticket necessary.
- "T3 SHOWCASE" (HEADLINERS ONLY, age's 9-18) will be Saturday, June 25 at 2:00 PM and 7:00 PM and Sunday, June 26 at 2:00 PM. Tickets are already on sale, so if you haven't bought your tickets do so quickly.
