## Saint Genevieve School Family Fundraising Program

The school funding guidelines of the Newark Archdiocese state that $10 \%$ of a school's operating budget must come from fundraising activities. In order for St. Genevieve School to meet this goal, it is necessary to impose a minimum fundraising requirement for each family. Although this requirement is relatively new at St. Genevieve, it is common at many private schools to expect all families to actively participate in fundraising activities. The following policy will be in place for the 2011-2012 school year. Please take some time and read the policy carefully. New fundraising ideas are always welcome, as well as any other input you may have.

## FUNDRAISING COMMITMENT:

Each family at St. Genevieve School will be responsible for raising at least $\$ 300.00$ through donations or fundraising activities.

## THE FUNDRAISING OBLIGATION CAN BE MET IN TWO WAYS:

1. Raise $\$ 450.00$ through approved fundraisers during the year. If this obligation is not met through fundraising, the remaining balance is to be contributed by the family of the enrolled student/students by April 15, 2012.
2. Contribute $\$ 300.00$ at the start of the 2011-2012 school year.

St. Genevieve will keep track of each family's fundraising totals and advise each family of their status at mid-year. As stated above, any portion of the $\$ 450.00$ fundraising commitment not earned through fundraising activities must be paid by April 15, 2012.
