This Training and Experience evaluation is a scored component accounting for 100% of your rating in the hiring process. It is important to complete the questionnaire carefully and accurately. Your responses are subject to verification before appointment to a position.

To answer all the test items (task statements) in this exam, you will be required to either choose from among the provided answers, or to enter (type in) specific information about your experience and your formal training. Work references will also be requested.

Be prepared to give specific information about the length and breadth of your work experience. Also, be prepared to provide specific information about where you received your training. Providing the type of or formal training courses will also be necessary to complete this examination.
