

## Marriage Licences

Issued by: Brampton City Hall, 2 Wellington Street West,  
City Clerk's Office, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor

Hours: 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday,  
excluding holidays. Applications will **not** be  
accepted for processing after 4:00 p.m.  
The marriage licence is issued while you wait.

Fee: \$135.00 (Cash, debit, Visa, MasterCard,  
American Express)

### Requirements:

- Both the Applicant and Joint Applicant **must** sign the marriage licence application.
- Marriage licences can only be issued to the Applicant and/or the Joint Applicant.
- For applicants **under the age of 18 but over 16, parental consent** is required on a form available from this office.
- The person(s) being issued the licence must speak and read English competently, or otherwise must be accompanied by an interpreter. It is the applicants' responsibility to provide an interpreter.
- If either party has been married previously and divorced:
  - In Canada – the **original** or **court certified copy** of the **Certificate of Divorce** is required. Photocopies will **not** be accepted. Originals or court certified copies may be obtained from the court which granted the divorce, and will be returned.
  - Outside Canada – further information is available from this office.

- **Identification** is required for both parties. We must be confident of your age and identity.

In order to prove age and identity you must provide us with **one** of the following (any of which must include a recent photo):

- Valid Passport
- Citizenship card
- Permanent Resident Card
- Canadian Government Refugee Document

**OR**

your original Birth Certificate **plus** another piece of photo identification

Identity documents **must be original** – photocopies will not be accepted.

**If we are not confident of your age or identity, we may ask you for further proof. Please contact us if you are unsure if your ID is appropriate.**

Licences can be purchased at most municipal offices in the Province of Ontario and can be used anywhere in the Province. They are valid for a period of 90 days from the date of issue.
