<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Current <b>Original passport</b> with a minimum validity of six months from the date of Application and must have at least <b>two blank page</b>. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Except Czech National – See details under <b>section D</b></li> </ul> </li> </ul>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● If your <b>occupation</b> selected on your Visa Application form is, <b>“Journalist”</b>, you may only apply for a Journalist Visa, even if you intend to travel for tourism or any work or non-work related purpose. Check Occupation on Form.</li> </ul>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>Mode of payment:-</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Eftpos / Credit card - MasterCard or Visa Card issued in Australia (at VFS counters)</li> <li>○ Cash (at VFS Counters only)</li> <li>○ Money / Postal Order payable to “VFS Services Australia Pty Ltd” only</li> <li>○ Post Applications- Complete Credit Card Authorization form</li> </ul> <b>Note:</b> - Personal Cheque and company Cheque are not acceptable.                      - Courier Fee is mandatory (Applications received by post will be sent by post)                 </li> </ul>		
Section B : Additional documents based on specific conditions		
Condition 1: Do you have a medical advice certificate?		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Applicants wishing to visit India for medical treatment should apply for Medical Visa (MV). Medical Visa is issued on the basis preliminary medical advice from the country of origin/residence and has been advised to go for specialized treatment. Person accompanying the patient would be issued Medical Attendant Visa (MX). Medical Visa would generally be issued up to 1 year or the period of treatment which ever is less. All applicants visiting India on medical visa are required to get registered within 14 days of arrival with concerned Foreigners Regional Registration Officer (FRRO)</li> </ul>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Medical Advice Certificate from the country of residence advising specialized treatment to be carried out</li> </ul>		
Condition 2: Are you planning to travel to India for Commissioning Surrogacy?		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Following conditions will be applicable:-</li> </ul>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The foreign man and woman are duly married and the marriage should have sustained at least for two years.</li> </ul>		

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<p>(ii) A letter from the Embassy of the foreign country in India or the Foreign Ministry of the country should be enclosed with the visa application stating clearly that</p> <p>(a) the country recognises surrogacy;</p> <p>(b) the child/children to be born to the commissioning couple through the Indian surrogate mother will be permitted entry into their country as a biological child/children of the couple commissioning surrogacy</p> <p>(iii) The couple will furnish an undertaking that they would take care of the child/children born thorough surrogacy</p> <p>(iv) Letter From Indian ART Clinic &amp; ICMR - The treatment should be done only at one of the registered (Assisted Reproductive Technology) ART clinics recognised by (Indian Council of Medical Research) ICMR.</p> <p>(v) The couple should produce a duly notarised agreement between the applicant couple and the prospective Indian surrogate mother.</p>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● If any of the above conditions are not fulfilled, the visa application shall not be processed and will be rejected. It may be noted that for drawing up and executing the agreement cited at para (ii) (v) above, the foreign couple can be permitted to visit India on a reconnaissance trip on <b>Tourist visa</b>, but no samples may be allowed from surrogate mother. Once the application is processed on the basis of production of all above documents, the appropriate visa category will be a medical visa.</li> </ul>		
<p><b>Condition 3: Are you planning to apply on a Foreign Passport? [Non- Australian Passport]</b></p>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● For Non Australian Passport holders, Photocopy of Visa Status showing valid visa OR Residency Proof from DIAC (Department of Immigration and Citizenship) issued within the last 1 month of the current date stating the type of Residency applied for e.g. Bridging Visa A awaiting Permanent Residency</li> </ul>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>EXCEPTION:</b> For example, if you are a DUAL national – Australia and UK, and wish to apply on your UK passport, submit a copy of the photo page of your Australian passport.</li> </ul>		
<p><b>Condition 4: Do you need to complete FORM D?</b></p>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● All Australian/Foreign passport holders who were previously nationals of Iran, China, Macau, Hong Kong, Taiwan, Pakistan, Afghanistan and DPRK must fill in the <b>FORM-D</b>. (Download form at <a href="http://www.vfsglobal.com/india/australia">www.vfsglobal.com/india/australia</a>)</li> <li>● All nationals of Iran, China, Macau, Hong Kong, Taiwan, Pakistan, Afghanistan and DPRK (whether Permanent Residents in Australia or not) must fill in the <b>FORM-D</b>.</li> <li>● All foreign nationals who are not Permanent Residents in Australia must fill in the <b>FORM-D</b>.</li> </ul>		
<p><b>Condition 5: Proof of Renunciation of your Indian Citizenship, if you were previously an Indian National (Indian Passport Law does not permit Dual Citizenship; therefore all Indian Nationals obtaining a Foreign Citizenship must renounce their Indian Citizenship)</b></p>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Provide a copy of any consular service availed after 1st June 2010 from the Indian mission in Australia (i.e. Visa / OCI / PIO) <b>OR</b> provide one of the following:-</li> </ul>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o If your Indian passport is <b>officially cancelled</b>, provide a photocopy of the bio page [page with photo and passport details].</li> </ul>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o If your Indian Passport is <b>not officially cancelled</b>, submit the original Indian Passport for cancellation, a copy of your Australian OR Foreign Citizenship Certificate and <b>FORM N</b>. (Download form at <a href="http://www.vfsglobal.com/india/australia">www.vfsglobal.com/india/australia</a>)</li> </ul>		

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o Also provide <b>FORM J</b> if your appearance in the Indian Passport and Australian Passport differs from the form. (Download form at <a href="http://www.vfsglobal.com/india/australia">www.vfsglobal.com/india/australia</a> )		
o If your name is different in the Australian/ Foreign passport from that of the Indian passport, submit a copy of your name change certificate (attested by a Justice of peace J.P.) <b>OR</b> a Statutory Declaration attested by a Justice of peace (J.P)		
o If your Indian Passport is lost and not in your possession, submit a Statutory Declaration attested by a Justice of Peace with details on the reason for the passport not being in your possession. Also submit a copy of your Australian <b>OR</b> Foreign Citizenship Certificate and <b>FORM N</b>		
<b>Section C : Additional documents for a minor ( child under 15 years)</b>		
● Copy of <b>Birth certificate</b> of minor. (In case of the minor’s father status being unknown, a Statutory Declaration attested by a Justice of Peace is required from the mother stating the same.)		
● Both parents current <b>Passport copy</b> (Page with photo/signature)		
● <b>Signature of both parents</b> on the visa application form <b>OR</b> No objection letter (letter of consent) signed by both parents		
● In the case of single parent/guardian submit additional documentary proof copies such as custody papers / death certificate of the deceased parent / proof of single parent status		
<b>Section D: Specific Nationality Criteria (Only if you are a national/ex-national or hold dual nationality with one of the countries listed here below)</b>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● If you currently <b>hold dual nationality of Pakistan and another country</b>, both passports need to be submitted. Visa will be issued on your Pakistani passport.</li> <li>● If you are <b>ex-national &amp; do not hold dual nationality of Pakistan and another country</b>, submit a statutory Declaration duly attested by a Justice of Peace stating that you do not hold Pakistani nationality.</li> <li>● As a <b>national of Pakistan</b> if you are only visiting one city in India, you must submit your application in quadruplet (four sets). If visiting two cities in India, you must submit in quintuplet (five sets). If visiting three cities in India, you must submit in six sets.</li> </ul>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● If you currently <b>hold dual nationality of Bangladesh</b> and another country, both passports need to be submitted. Visa will be issued on your Bangladeshi passport.</li> <li>● If you are <b>ex-national &amp; do not hold dual nationality of Bangladesh</b> and another country, submit a Statutory Declaration duly attested by a Justice of Peace stating that you do not hold Bangladeshi nationality.</li> </ul>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● If you currently <b>hold dual nationality of Sri Lanka</b> and another country, both passports need to be submitted. Visa will be issued on your Sri Lankan passport.</li> <li>● If you are <b>ex-national &amp; do not hold dual nationality of Sri Lanka</b> and another country, submit a Statutory Declaration duly attested by a Justice of Peace stating that you do not hold Sri Lankan nationality.</li> </ul>		
● If you currently hold a <b>New Zealand Passport and are a permanent resident of Australia</b> , submit a copy of your Medicare card.		

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<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● If you currently hold a <b>Czech Republic</b> Passport, you may apply only if you meet the following conditions<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ You must have stayed in Australia, for at least one year, prior to applying.</li><li>○ Hold a Passport with at least 1 year validity from the date of application.</li><li>○ Present medical insurance for the entire period of proposed stay in India.</li></ul></li></ul>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● <b>Chinese passport</b> holder of <b>Type-P</b> Passport with number beginning with the <b>Alphabet E</b> can apply for Indian Visa from mainland China only.</li></ul>
