WHAT IS AAMTC America's Amateur Model & Talent Competition is for girls young women and is dedicated to the advancement of modeling and talent through competitive events, the establishment of professional ethics and the standardization of training. The competition is open to all amateur models and/or those engaged in the performing arts, regardless of their affiliation with any other modeling or talent association or pageant. CASUALWEAR

WHO MAY COMPETE IN AAMTC Any amateur may enter AAMTC (anyone who has not made more than \$6,000 in a calendar year through either a modeling or talent contract). REGISTRATION FEE Free is required to participate in the AAMTC - Each

 REGISTRATION FEE

 A \$40 Registration Fee is required to participate in the AAMTC - Each modeling or talent category entered is \$20. Cameo Girl Pageant is \$80. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

 Events have been scheduled so that contestants may participate in every category, especially those who are trying for the overall awards. MODELING & TALENT SOLO AGE DIVISIONS

 Competitive modeling and talent events will be broken into the following age divisions: 3-4, 5-6, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-17, 18 & Over -married or sinele. Are divisions might be combined.

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 Modeling and for Talent or that age division division in either Modeling or Talent may be cancelled.

 MODELING PROCEDURE

 AAMTC is "free style" and there is no set modeling pattern. The only requirement is that participants begin their modeling presentations at the first "X" (stage right) and that they reach the final position, the last "X" (stage left) before the end of the final harp sweep. The official AAMTC Runway/Modeling Music is available on cassette tape at a nominal cost for practice at home before competitions. If you are not familiar with the music, DON'T WORRY! During the Saturday evening orientation session participants will have the opportunity to practice their modeling with the official music!

 DESCRIPTION OF MODELING CATEGORIES

 PARTYWEAR / COCKTAIL

 (Required Modeling Category)

 The correct dress for this division will be short or tea-length dress that would be appropriate for the participant if she were attending a party or social event.

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Outfit should be one which would be worn at a casual social function such as church, a personal interview, etc. Suggested styles of clothing would be a casual dress, skirt and blouse, slacks with jacket, etc. SWIMWEAR

Any type of swimsuit selected by the participant. Swimsuit selection should be in good taste and appropriate for the age division of the participant. In this category a swimsuit "cover-up" may be worn and removed during modeling but is not required.

The participant should select a garment that reflects a casual or very informal mood. Suggested styles are sundress, pant suits, skirts with blouse. An outfit that one might wear while shopping or attendening a casual brunch.

FORMALWEAR Long or tea-length gown which would be worn to a formal evening occasion such as a wedding, formal party, ball, etc. SLEEPWEAR/LOUNGEWEAR Pajamas, nightshirt or night gown is appropriate attire for this modeling category. NOTE: In this category the participant may wear and remove a robe during the modeling presentation: however, it is not required. WESTERN WEAR The appropriate wardrobe could be as practical as blue jeans and boots or as whimsical as a "rhinestone cowboy" look. The judges will be looking for any outfit, serious or fun, that evokes a "western wear" look. PHOTOGENIC Judged on photogenic qualities of participant. Turn in photo at registration. (DO NOT MAIL). Photo may be black & white or color. Photos will be returned. Judged on photographic beauty, mood or expression and quality of photograph. photograph.

SOLO TALENT COMPETITION

SOLO TALENT COMPETITION Entrants may enter as many talent categories as desired; however they may NOT enter more than one talent act within a category. Presentations should be about 2-minutes in length but may NOT EXCEED 2:30 minutes. Hand props, but NO SCENERY, are allowed. Having your own piano accompanist or pre-recorded accompaniment is recommended. A piano, cassette tape player and microphone. will be provided. Any other equipment is the participant's own responsibility. No type of fire or knife act or special lighting effects will be allowed. A minimum of 5 participants must be entered in a division or the division may be cancelled.

MUSIC

MUSIC Talent participants must furnish their own music on a CD. The Official AAMTC Modeling Music, which may be purchased on the Entry Form, will be used for all modeling events. Each selection, which is precisely timed to give equal time to each competitor, includes a 10-second electronic warning tone before the end of the music. There is an additional 5-second harp sweep to complete the presentation. AAMTC modeling is "free style" and the participant may use any modeling pattern so long as the routine is completed by the final harp sweep. A demonstration of the will be held prior to the modeling competition. competition.

competition. CAMEO GIRL PAGEANT The "Cameo Model" has long been revered in the modeling profession for her classic features and flawless beauty. In the Cameo Girl Pageant, participants in the 3-4 yr, 5-6 yr, 7-8 yr, 9-10 yr, 11-12 yr divisions will be judged in street length party dress and the participants in the 13-14 yr, 15-17 yr and 18 & Over divisions will be judged in full length formal. The participants will be required to state their name, age and hometown at the microphone during their modeling presentation. The introduction will take place during the first "rhythm void" in the official modeling music just before the participant makes her turns for the judges. Awards in <u>each age division</u>: 1st - 4th alternate trophies; Overall Winner: Official "Cameo Girl" international title, banner, crown, trophy and \$250 CASH AWARD. \$250 CASH AWARD

SPECTATOR TICKET PACKAGE PLANS

Participants receive an admittance badge at no charge; however all spectators (including parents) must either purchase an AAMTC Ticket Package Plan (a \$20.00 value for only \$15.00) or pay at the door for each competitive session.
