An applicant must be a Juneau County Livestock Show and Sale exhibitor and have completed at least their sophomore year in high school. Past recipients are not eligible to compete for this scholarship.

Receiving completed applications does not necessarily mean that the scholarship will be awarded. The final decision rests with the Selection Committee. The completed application must be returned to the Juneau County UW-Extension Office on or before July 1 of the current year.
