FIG. 4 is a front elevation view thereof;

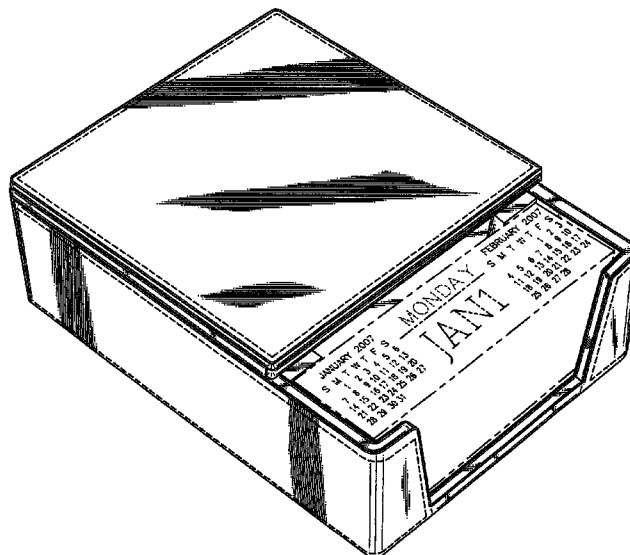
FIG. 5 is a side elevation view thereof, the other side being a mirror image; and,

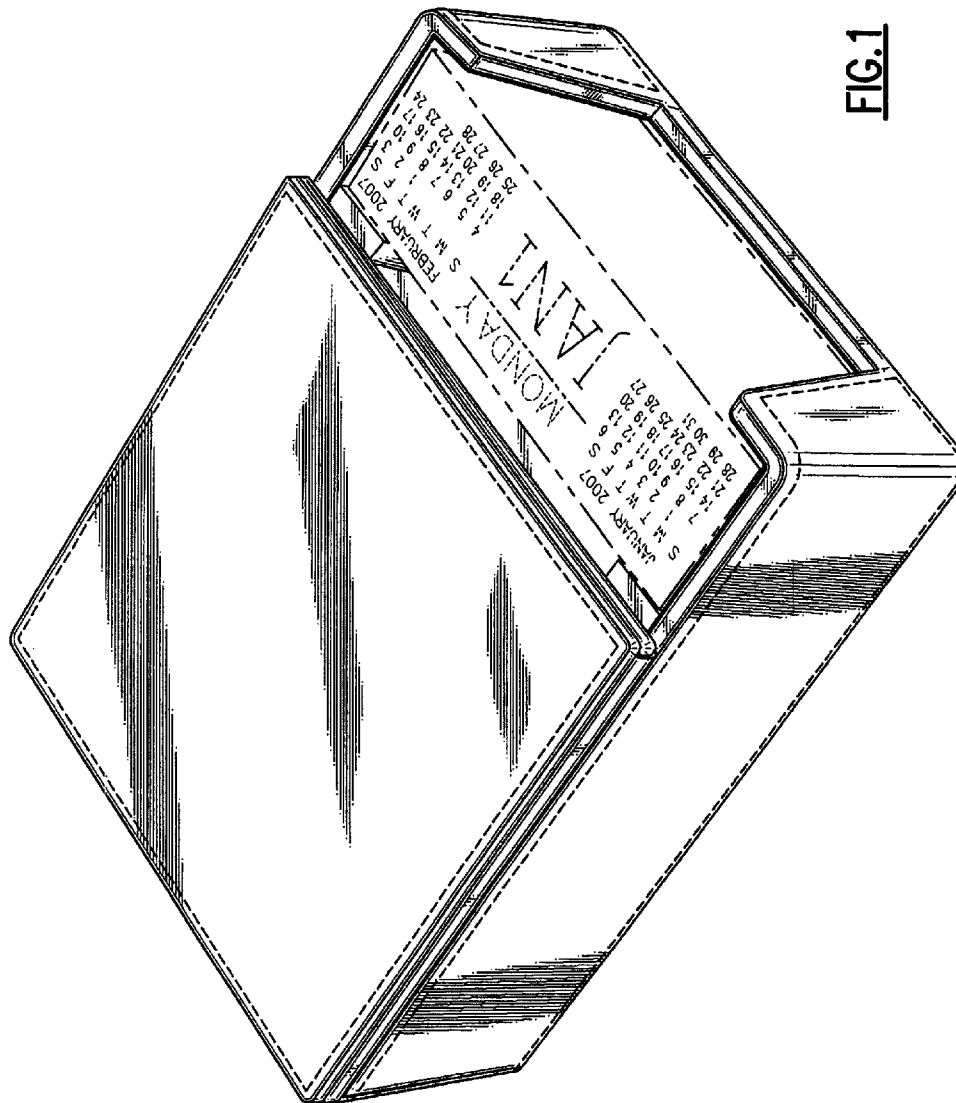
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

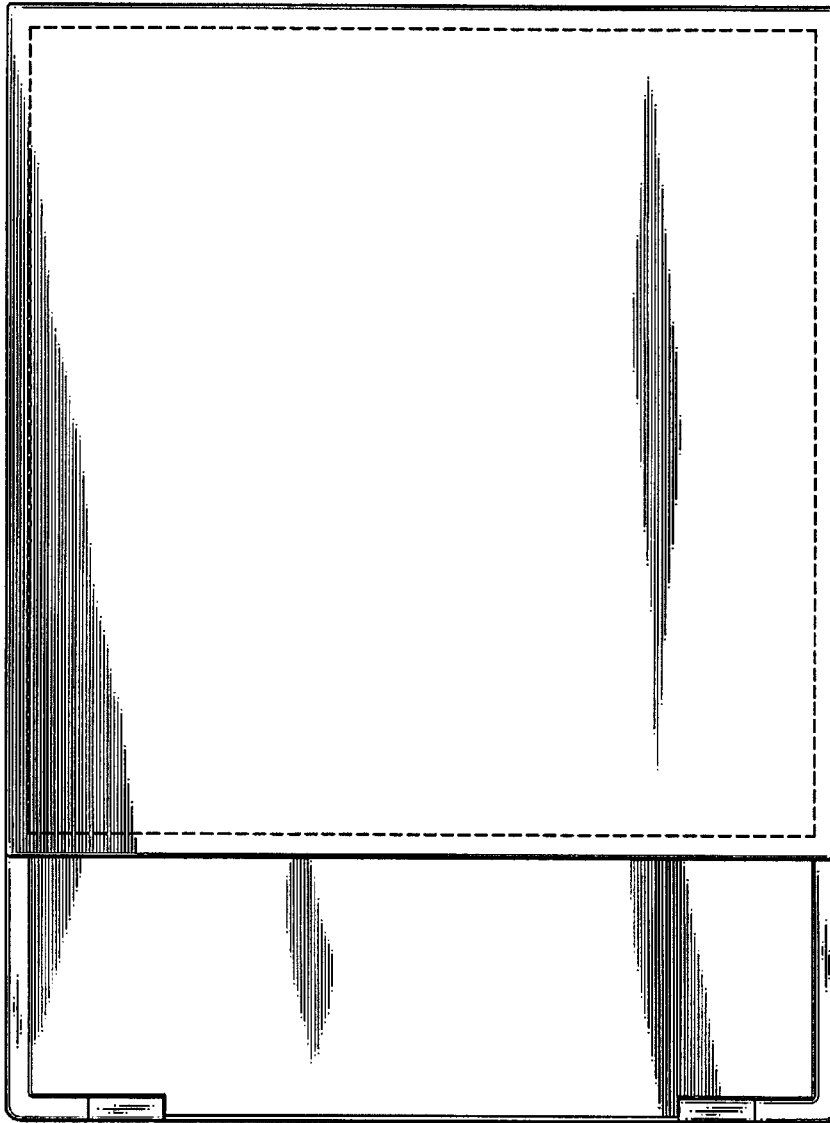

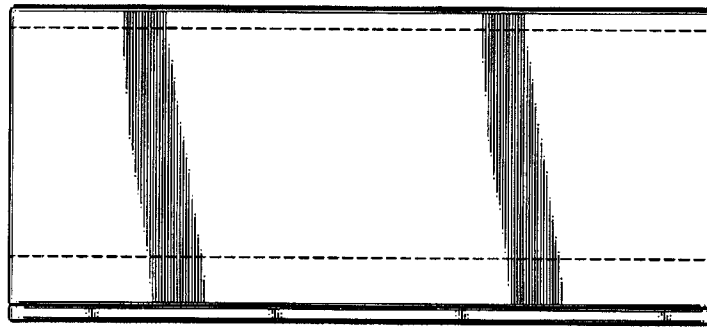

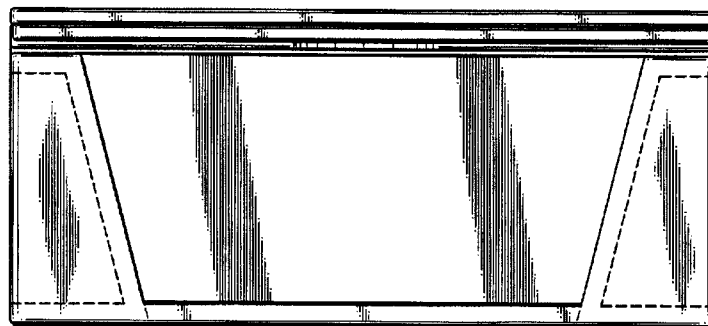

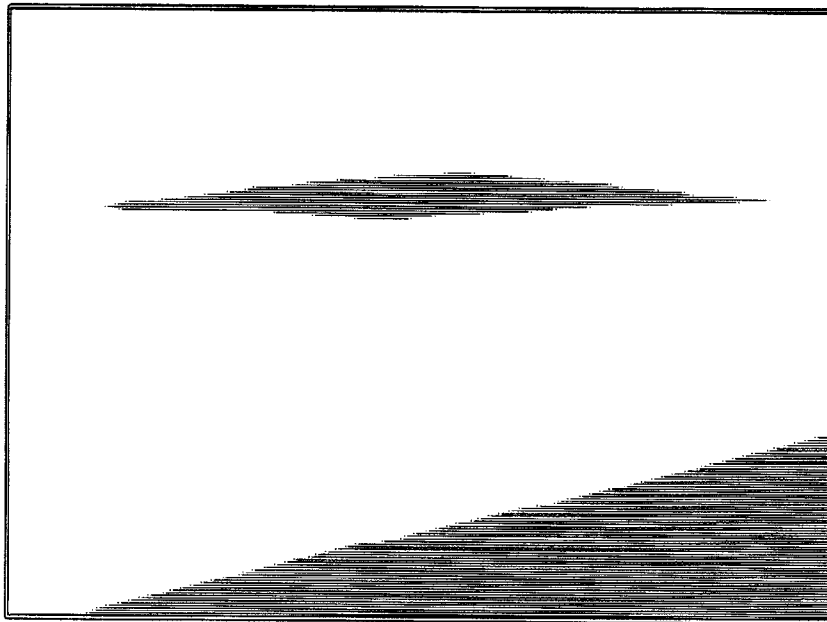
