Course Description:

This course prepares participants to deliver Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) CERT *Basic Training* course.

Course Goal:

This train-the-trainer course focuses on preparing instructors to:

- 1. Deliver the CERT Basic Training
- 2. Convey the messages and intent of the CERT Program (e.g., safety, teamwork, place in overall community emergency operations plan)
- 3. Assure that students achieve the objectives of the CERT Basic Training
- 4. Create a comfortable yet managed learning environment.

Prerequisite:

Participants in this course must have:

- 1. A referral from a CERT-sponsoring agency, typically a local, regional, or state government agency
- Completed the CERT Basic Training course or IS317: Introduction to CERT (http://www.citizencorps.gov/cert/IS317/)

Course Length:

2 ½ days

Target Audience:

The audience for this course includes those who will have or currently have either of the following responsibilities: Serve as the course manager for the *CERT Basic Training* course or serves as a *CERT Basic Training* course manager.

Continuing Education Units (CEUs):

The Emergency Management Institute (EMI) awards 2.3 CEUs for completion of this course.

To Apply:

Complete a FEMA Form 75-5, General Admissions Application with student signature and signature of supervisor or sponsoring agency official. Submit the application through the State Emergency Management Training Office who will fax it to the National Emergency Training Center (NETC) Admissions Office at (301) 447-1658.
