

New College Student Alliance (NCSA) Duties & Expectations Document

Office: Student Court Justice

Last Updated: 3 November 2013

Duration of Term: January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014

Student Court Justices shall:

- attend all meetings and hearings of the Student Court;
- conduct themselves impartially in all proceedings; and,
- serve as student representatives to the college Community Board.

The Student Court shall have jurisdiction:

- over questions involving the constitutionality of actions taken by NCSA officials and organizations;
- over violations of the NCSA Constitution, the Great Book, or any other NCSA regulation;
- over disputes involving the allocation of NCSA funds; over other disputes involving the NCSA; and, over disputes between students.

The Student Court shall:

- hear all impeachment hearings, except those of Student Court Justices, which shall be heard by a Special Tribunal as outlined in Chapter 507 of the NCSA Great Book.
- decide whether or not to remove the official. The Student Court may impose other sanctions in accordance with Chapter 505 of the Great Book.
- ensure all NCSA elections are conducted according to the provisions of Title VII of the NCSA Great Book (The Election Codes).
- meet at least once a month during the fall and spring terms to discuss matters of import, give advisory opinions, and consider whether or not any complaints deserve a hearing.
- adopt its own rules of practice and procedure
- conduct all of its hearings openly
