### 1. Key dates

#### 2. Common Tests

Our teachers provide feedback for learning in many ways to your child. Part of this involves the conduct of Common Tests on Friday from 7:45am to 8:30am. These are scheduled tests that will support their growth and familiarise them with examination processes. The first Common Test will be on Fri 16 Jan, and the schedule can be found on the school website.

### 3. Mother Tongue Newspaper Reading Programme

To help your child develop a habit of reading widely and attain a high standard of language proficiency, the school has in place a newspaper reading programme using publications such as Zaobao Comma, Berita Harian and Thumbs-up (1NT to 4NT CL students) to expose them to a wide variety of news and current affairs. This programme will equip your child with general knowledge and language skills. Your child will be guided and his / her progress will be monitored by the Mother Tongue teachers during the Mother Tongue periods. Please also read together with your child to support him/her.

# 4. National Youth Achievement Award (NYAA)

The NYAA is a national award scheme to encourage our students to take part in a range of activities that will develop them holistically. The Award is a part of our Secondary 2 Adventure and Leadership Camp to be held at the Sarimbun Scout Camp, and more information about the Award and Camp will be sent to you separately.

# 6. Sexuality Education (SEd)

Sexuality Education (SEd) in schools is about enabling students to understand the physiological, social and emotional changes they experience as they mature, develop healthy and rewarding relationships including those with members of the opposite sex, and make wise, informed and responsible decisions on sexuality matters. importance of the family as the basic unit of society. This means encouraging healthy, heterosexual marriages and stable nuclear family units with extended family support. The teaching and learning of SEd is based on respect for the values and beliefs of the different ethnic and religious communities in Singapore on sexuality issues.
