2. Mid-Year Examinations

The Mid-Year Examinations will be held from Mon, 27 Apr to Fri, 8 May. A copy of your child's examination timetable and school examination guidelines is attached to this letter. Lessons will continue as usual until the last day indicated, except for the dates for the English and Mother Tongue papers.

During the exams:

- 1. If there are no lessons or papers, students need not report to school.
- 2. If students have a paper starting at 0800, they must report for assembly at 0730.
- 3. All Sec 1 to 3 examinations will be administered in the classroom.
- 4. Secondary 4 and 5 classes will take their examinations in the hall (except for listening comprehension and practical papers).
- 5. Students need to adhere to school guidelines for attire and behaviour during the examinations.

Students should not absent themselves from examinations, unless certified medically unfit for examinations. As there will be no resitting of papers, students absent without a valid medical certificate will be awarded zero. Late-comers will also not be given extra time.

Finally, Mon, 11 May, is a marking day, and students need not report for school.
