Sleepy Hollow Elementary School Revue | 97

Enjoy and learn from one hour of instruction daily June 13-24, with a performance June 24th. Features creative movement and theatrical imagination games. Sleepy Hollow Middle School Revue | 98

Intensive instruction on how to become a triple threat performer including improvisation, creative dance and vocal diversity. Three hours of instruction daily June 6-28, 9 am-12 noon, with a public show on July 28. CLASS DESCRIPTION | CODE

Advanced Art of Harry Potter | 335

This class is designed for Harry Potter fans who are going into grades 7-12. Similar to the Harry Potter Camp but with more advanced projects, book discussions, and activities—students will enjoy this deeper experience. Through they will experience the magical world and be sorted into houses students will also have the freedom to take the projects in their own directions to fit any fandom they may be into!

Aliens, UFO's and Monsters | 211, 301

Students will use their imagination to draw, paint and sculpt original aliens, UFO's and monsters.

Animals Animals Animals | 110

Have fun being other animal lovers as you learn basic techniques to draw, paint and sculpt your favorite animals and creatures!

Art Expression for the Very Young | 111

Let's scribble and splatter outside the borders. Students will experiment with different types of paint and drawing media. This is a great class for self-expression.

Art of Harry Potter Camp | 235

If you are a fan of the Harry Potter books or movies you will love this class. Come expecting to be sorted into houses and work hard to win the house cup! Create your own wands and wand boxes, brew up some interesting potions, make spell books, sculpt your favorite magical creature, visit Honey Duke's sweet shop, plant something interesting in herbology, play Quidditch and lots more! Includes new magical projects and adventures different from last year.

Basic Drawing | 122

Learn the basics of drawing which is the foundation of all art making. Discover drawing with different types of drawing media.

Beauty in Nature | 121

Students will be introduced to the beauty in nature by learning how to paint with watercolors and Japanese fabric paints for painting on silk. They will discover how much fun it is to create images using a digital camera and using those images to enrich their paintings.

Beginning Painting | 351

Basic techniques with acrylic and watercolors will be explored. Students will splatter, scrape, spray and use a variety of combinations of paint and mixed media. A great class for self-expression.

Cherry Blossom Geisha | 135, 245, 305

Come to the Orient through learning to paint on a Kimono and Obi made especially for you! Students will learn about the Japanese culture and wear their beautiful Kimono during a special Tea Ceremony. This would be a great class for a mom and daughter to share this great experience together. Only requirement is when you register, please include your size.*

Creative Clay | 137

Students will make hand-build projects using pinch, coil and stab techniques. The class will look at historical and contemporary clay pieces. Students will make functional and non-functional pieces.

Creative Japanese Wall Hangings | 210

Students learn the beautiful world of Japanese Shibori (Tie-Dye) and they will make beautiful wall hangings. Students will learn how to paint on the dyed silk fabric to create stunning art designs to grace your home.

Creative Sculpture | 336

Students will explore with several forms of sculpture and media. Learn some basics and explore the creativity. Students may use foam, wood, cardboard or other materials in creating their sculptures.

Creative Tie-Dye & Shibori | 220

Learn the basics of how to tie-dye fabric and also the wonderful art of Japanese Tie-Dye Shibori. Students need to bring a 100% cotton t-shirt for the first day of class. Students will be able to tie-dye other items of clothing and this makes a nice gift for mom or dad.

Draw, Paint and Collage | 250

A variety of supplies will be used and a little creativity in cutting in cutting and gluing to make collage pieces of art. The class will explore torn paper, magazine images and scraps of paper. Painting and drawing will also be used in this expressive class.

Draw, Paint and Sculpt Animals | 142

Students will learn to use basic shapes when drawing animals. The class will learn to apply textures, color and value to the painted animal. Students will also have the opportunity to sculpt their favorite animals.

Drawing and Painting Dinosaurs and Making Fossils | 232

A great class for the child who loves science and art. Students will be taught basic drawing techniques. Drawing, painting and sculpting will be emphasized in class. The class will also walk to the ND Heritage Museum.

Drawing Cartoons and Comics | 130

Cartoons can be anything—people, animals, food or objects! Have fun and explore simple ways to use your imagination to create your own characters, expressions, features and personalities for your characters. Learn ways to turn them into simple comic strips and comic books if you wish!

Exploring Watercolors | 221

Students will learn basic watercolor techniques and using watercolor pencils. The class will look at such artists as Homer, Wyeth and Paul Klee for inspiration. A great class for experimentation.

Fun Creations for Your Room | 311

Use your creativity to craft fun things to bring life to your room! Create your own bulletin boards, unique storage containers, picture frames, wall decorations and more!

Geisha Accessories | 201

Every Geisha has her accessories to complete her outfit which students will paint their own umbrella, chop sticks and fan.

Glass Etching | 230, 350

Create wonderful glass designs by etching glass. Students will make a small hanging ornament and etch a large mirror tile. Students can also bring items like classes to etch which can serve a functional purpose and still have fun.
