Individual Camp Philosophy |

| What to Bring |

All campers should wear or bring appropriate basketball gear. Overnight campers are also expected to bring their own linens, pillows, blankets/sleeping bag, towels, as well as toiletries and other articles of clothing needed. While all campers will receive a camp t-shirt upon arrival, extra spending money may be helpful for the purchase of snacks and other camp gear for sale.

| Facilities |

Three top-of-the-line facilities will be utilized for our camps. The **Kiewit Fitness Center** is a 2.5 acre air-conditioned building featuring five full-sized courts with scoreboards on each. Creighton's **Vinardi Center** has two air-conditioned college-length courts and practice area with ten baskets. Our new facility, the **Ryan Athletic Center and D.J. Sokol Arena** will also be used during camps. All facilities are located on Creighton's campus.

Individual Camps Housing |

Overnight campers will be housed in rooms located in the air-conditioned Kiewit and Gallagher residence halls. Space may be limited. Please apply early to ensure housing availability. While supervision will be provided by Creighton camp counselors, campers are responsible for their room keys. There will be a \$25 fee for any lost room keys.

| Team Camp Housing |

A member of each team's coaching staff or someone serving as coach must accompany teams in the residence halls. Although there will be representatives from Creighton in the halls at all times, team coaches are responsible for the supervision of their players.

| Health Insurance |

All campers must carry their own health insurance. While qualified athletic trainers are on duty 24 hours a day during camp, Creighton Women's Basketball Camp and Creighton University cannot be responsible for injuries sustained at camp.

| Meals |

Meals will be planned by our expert university staff and served in an air-conditioned dining hall. Pizza parties will also be featured at camp.
