

For example if a 2 person team is +1 over for their combined quota and the other 2 person team is -1 under for their combined quota, that team (+1) wins the 3rd point.
- POINT SYSTEM: 8 points for an Eagle, 4 points for a Birdie, 2 points for a Par, and 1 point for a Bogey.
- No points for a Double Bogey. Players should pick up their ball after their bogey shot to keep the Pace of Play.
- Stableford Formula: Each player's Quota is determined by Subtracting their Handicap from 36. Quotas will be adjusted after week 3 for week's 4 and 5 Quotas.
