## The Beaufort

- \* Totally Australian Built - 700 were built in our country.
- \* It shows what our nation can do when the “chips are down”.
- \* Some 39,000 personnel built the Beauforts - 35% of that workforce were women.
- \* Built at the DAP assembly plants at Fishermens Bend (VIC) and Mascot (NSW).
- \* Built, in part, by the State Railway Workshops (Chullora NSW, Islington SA).
- \* Some 600 Sub-contractors were involved - which included many of Australia’s largest and most well-known companies:

General Motors Holden (GMH)  
Amalgamated Wireless Australasia (AWA)  
Imperial Chemical Industries (ICI)  
Broken Hill Proprietary (BHP)  
National Motor Springs.  
Plus many more who are still trading today



## Fact Sheet-A9-141

- \* Served in the Royal Australian Air Force between 1942 and 1944
- \* Posted to 7 and 14 Squadrons and 1 Operational Training Unit
- \* It is a National Trust heritage listed item
- \* It will be the only flying example in the world
- \* There are no other complete examples of this type of aircraft in the world.
