Each entrant will receive:- Entrant Sash, entry to the Sunshine Coast Agricultural Show, ticket to the Show Dinner, letter of achievement and reference for resume, team building activities and wonderful prizes supplied by local business sponsors.

Senior Categories: Senior categories of the Showgirl and Rural Ambassador Competition are expected to represent the Sunshine Coast Agricultural Show at the Sub-Chamber finals of each respective competition. Winners of this have a once in a life time opportunity to represent the region at the Queensland Royal 'Ekka' Show in the state finals.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The following conditions apply for each of the categories. To qualify for this competition each entrant is required to:-

- Attend and participate in major fundraising events leading up to the Show;
- Contribute to the promotion of the Sunshine Coast Agricultural Show;
- Attend all advised Showgirl and Rural/Show Ambassador events;
- Attend People's Day at the Sunshine Coast Agricultural Show on Friday;
- Participate in Show Opening Ceremony and Grand Parade during the Show with fellow entrants; and
- Be an Australian Citizen.
- NOTE: Categories with age limit- to be the required age as at 1st Aug 2016.

Categories:

- ★ Showgirl Competition for young ladies aged between 18-28 years, who have an interest in the Sunshine Coast Show and who have the potential to be a good representative of the show
- ★ Rural Ambassador Competition for young people aged between 20-29 years who have a strong affiliation towards agriculture, knowledge about current rural issue and agricultural shows
- ★ Junior Showgirl Competition for young ladies aged between 14-17 years, who have an interest in the Sunshine Coast Show and who have the potential to be a good representative of the show
- ★ Junior Show Ambassador Competition for young people under the age of 20 years, who have an interest in or are actively involved in the show. This section aims to provide a stepping stone into the senior competitions, and to recognise the dedication youth have to the Sunshine Coast show
- ★ All Abilities Competition for young people who have an interest in the Sunshine Coast show and who have the potential to be a good representative of their local community

Senior Showgirl and Rural Ambassador Competition

Winners of the Showgirl and Rural Ambassador Competition will be expected to represent the Sunshine Coast Agricultural Show at the Near North Coast Sub-Chamber finals of each respective competition. The winner of the Sub-Chamber goes on to represent the region at the State Finals held at the Brisbane Royal 'Ekka' Show in August.

The Near North Coast Sub-chamber final is hosted by different shows throughout the region annually and is held at the end of June or early July. In 2016, the Sunshine Coast Agricultural Show will be hosting the Sub-Chamber Finals on the 25th of June

Senior winners of the Showgirl and Rural Ambassador competition will be required to complete the forms detailed below. These will be provided by the Coordinator at the time of winning. We require the forms to be fully completed and forwarded back to the Coordinator by the due date. The Sunshine Coast Agricultural Show will be responsible for ensuring the forms are received by the host show society of the Sun-Chamber finals.
