Day 4. Wednesday 21st December 2016: Alotau, Papua New Guinea**Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner****Ship Docked 8.00am to 7.00pm**

Welcome to an undiscovered paradise of white-sand beaches, crystal waterfalls and volcanic mountains. And if you've come for history, you'll find that, too. This peaceful town was the site of fierce fighting during World War II. Today, it's a peaceful retreat offering the vacationer plenty of time to relax and connect with nature. Beyond the city you'll find a tropical rainforest full of birds of paradise and a laid-back ease worth discovering.

Here, one of the world's most intact island cultures resides on one of the world's most untouched islands, and you are among the select few who are lucky enough to experience them both. Located in Papua New Guinea's Milne Bay Province, Kitava is a small island off the main Trobriand Island of Kiriwina. Here life remains as it was thousands of years ago with very little external influence. The landing site is surrounded by stunning white sand beaches lined with natural shade-trees, just offshore lies the picture perfect sand atoll Nuratu Island. This truly is a slice of heaven.

Overnight: Sea Princess**Day 6. Friday 23rd December 2016: Rabaul Papua New Guinea****Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner****Ship Docked 9.00am to 5.00pm**

Located on Papua New Guinea's northeastern tip, this province - blessed with natural beauty but plagued with an unlucky past - has literally risen from the ashes. The former capital of New Britain is a town with a colourful history and no stranger to rebuilding itself from the ground up. It's been destroyed by volcano eruptions in 1937 and 1994, as well as being all but flattened by aerial bombardment in World War II. Its kilometres of underground tunnels built by the Japanese during its occupation in World War II are a testament to its wartime past. Since 1994, Rabaul has returned to life and its harbour is still one of the most impressive in the entire Pacific basin.

Doini Island is made up of 1000 hectares of incredible landscape; most of it uncharted territory just waiting to be explored. Beautiful white beaches line its shores and the photo opportunities are once-in-a-lifetime. Despite being one of Papua New Guinea's few private islands, it's virtually untouched, so make sure to adjust your watch to island time and enjoy the serenity.

HOW TO CONFIRM YOUR PLACE ON THE TOUR

A \$500 deposit will be required for this tour by nominated deposit date.

The balance of your tour is payable 90 days prior to your tour's departure. For bookings made within 90 days, full payment is required immediately. If payment is not received by the due date, Trade Travel reserves the right to cancel your place on the tour and you will incur cancellation fees.

CHANGES TO YOUR BOOKING

Any changes to your booking once the non refundable deposit has been received will incur an amendment fee of \$75.00. Bookings changed within 90 days of departure will be subject to the \$75.00 fee plus any additional charges levied by airlines, hotels, ground operators.
