### FACILITIES

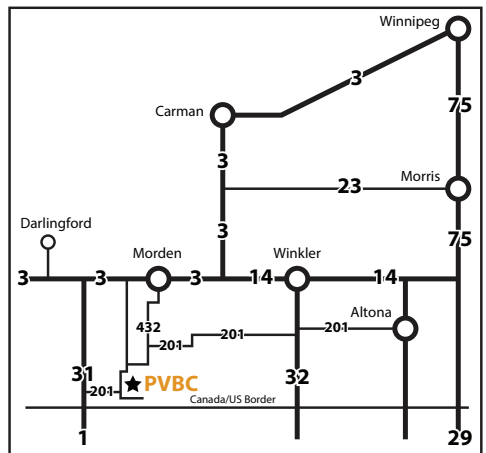
Accommodations for girls are two storey chalets, complete with bathroom facilities. Guys stay in cabins with access to a shower house.
