#### WHO WE ARE

PVBC is an interdenominational, evangelical Christian camp, founded in 1975 and in operation year round. PVBC is a not-for-profit organization and a member of Christian Camping International. Daily recreation and spiritual pursuits are lead by our staff through camp games, specific skills, Bible studies and devotions.
