RE: How to Apply for a NYS Credit Union League College Scholarship

- 1. Complete the attached scholarship application form. Applicants should type or print clearly, and use <u>only</u> the space provided on the form to answer the questions. Other than specified on the application form, no attachments, resumes, pictures or other material of any kind should be used to answer the questions or should be submitted.
- 2. The signed application must be submitted together with:

 An official high school transcript documenting your GPA for grade 9 through
grade 11.
An SAT/PSAT/ACT transcript (obtained through the high school guidance office)
A typed, essay response.

- 3. The applicant and his/her parent or guardian must sign the Certification and Release Authorization on the back page of the application form.
- 4. The application, transcripts and essay must be returned to the credit union by **Friday**, **January 26**, **2007**. If any portion is incomplete or not included, the application will not be considered.
- 5. The application **must** be signed by a participating New York credit union management-level employee in order to verify the applicant's/member's eligibility.
