- 5. Property is posted *No Trespassing*. Occupancy and use of the property is limited to registered guests, listed above. All others are subject to arrest for trespassing.

The tenant has read and agrees to follow all of the attached occupancy rules. Further, the tenant understands that failure to follow these rules will result in immediate eviction, loss of the rental payment and loss of the security deposit.

Tenant agrees to maintain the property in the same condition in which it was found, reasonable wear and tear excepted.

Island View Lodge Occupancy Rules

- 1. Smoking is not permitted on the premises.
- 2. Pets are not allowed.
- Grilling is permitted only on the LP grill provided.
- 4. Tents, RV's, and Travel Trailers are not permitted on the grounds at any time.
- 5. Use of firearms, pellet guns, BB guns and paint-ball guns are prohibited.
- 6. All trees and other vegetation on the property are protected. DO NOT cut or damage any trees, living or dead. Firewood is available for purchase.
- 7. Due to the risk of wildfire, use of fireworks is prohibited at all times.
- 8. Campfires are restricted to the fire pit provided. The fire screen must be used at all times. Place cold ashes into the metal ash container provided.
- 9. Personal Watercraft (Jet Skis/PWC's) are not allowed.
- 10. Use of ATV's, dirt bikes, and Off Road Vehicles is not permitted anywhere on the premises.
- 11. Do not feed the wildlife. This is bear country.
- 12. Please respect your neighbors' right to quite enjoyment of the wilderness. Quiet hours are from 10 PM to 8 AM.
- 13. Please turn off the generator, when you do not need electricity.
