The Children's Museum of Science and Technology (CMOST) has great news for your and your students! Thanks to our generous partners at NYSERDA, CMOST is able to offer free group visits for the month of September and October 2009 for our new *Investigations in Energy* program for children in grades **4-6**.

These trips are being funded through the Discover Science grant program. In order to be considered to receive a subsidized group visit you must complete the enclosed Discover Science grant application and return it to CMOST as soon as possible. In exchange for a subsidized trip, all participating teachers will be required to complete a short program evaluation based on their experience at CMOST.

Applications will be processed on a first come, first served basis and can be submitted immediately. Highest preference will be given to schools that offer a higher percentage of free or reduced lunches, Title I schools and schools that are more than 60 miles round trip away from The Museum.
