Our Miracle Fund currently stands at 43,996. We are very thankful and excited as we see that fund grow in just a few short months and sow for a greater harvest down the road. Is the miracle already underway? Are we excited about what God has already done? In the next few weeks you will see a progress chart on the front wall . It will challenge us to not only move ahead in the Miracle Fund, but remind us about our vision at First Lobo....remember R.U.N? We hope it will be both informative and fun as we see our little runner move along the path to success.

September 11<sup>th</sup> will be a special day at First Lobo. Pastor Archie will conclude a mini-series on Stewardship of our Time, Talents and Treasure. This is also the day we look for everyone to return the Miracle Fund Cans. They can be returned any Sunday, but that day will be a special opportunity as we continue to work towards our cash financial goal of 120,00 by Dec 3,2011, and a further \$700,000 in cash by next spring during construction. The cans were initiated with 3 purposes in mind.

- 1. They are a daily reminder for prayer, and giving as they sit on your table or counter.
- 2. They create a discussion when visitors to your home ask what the cans are about, giving you the opportunity to explain how God is directing us, the importance of prayer in this project and what our goals are.
- They help create an opportunity for family discussion and teaching about regular and special needs giving to the Lord's work at First Lobo and how we believe God is leading us as we look to replace worn out buildings and allow us to provide a better facility to do Ministry. While children and adults should deposits coins/bills on a regular basis together, we fully recognize that this method alone will not produce the entire cash we will need. In a sense, the cans are simply a reminder or symbol of what we believe God will accomplish in the months and years ahead, as opposed to a means to an end. We continue to recognize the need for donations of all sizes, beyond the use of cans. On September 11<sup>th</sup>, you will be given the opportunity to prayerfully consider what you and your family feel led to do in a greater financial way over the forthcoming months. As we continue to pray as individuals and a Church for a miracle from God, we trust that God will direct you to be a part of that miracle.
