ICA Course Descriptions

Confined Space Competent Person Training

This two-hour course is designed to provide training for an individual so that an employer may designate this individual to be a "Competent Person," and is intended for safety directors, line foremen and field personnel. The course will cover compliance with, definition of, scope and application of, general requirements of, entrant, attendant and supervisor duties and training for 29 CFR 1910.146 Permit Required Confined Space. Participants will receive a certificate of course completion, participant manual, employee training requirements and sample confined space program documentation.

Fall Protection for the Construction Industry

Designed for safety directors, superintendents, line foremen and field personnel, this two-hour course will help employers recognize and correct fall hazards on the jobsite and ensure compliance with OSHA Fall Protection requirements. Participants will receive a certificate of course completion.

Lock-Out/Tag-Out Training for the Construction Industry (provided in conjunction with Confined Space Competent Person Training)

This one-hour course is designed for safety directors, superintendents, line foremen, field personnel, mechanics, and shop supervisors. The course teaches participants compliance with, scope and application of, definition of, general requirements and energy control procedures of 29 CFR 1910.147. Participants will receive a certificate of course completion.

OSHA 10-Hour Construction Industry Course

Designed for safety directors, line foremen and field personnel, this two-day course is tailored specifically for the building, highway and utility construction industry. Participants who successfully complete the course will receive a wallet-size card.

OSHA 30-Hour for the Construction Industry

Designed for safety directors and personnel who administer safety programs for construction contractors, this four-day course covers the same topics as those in the OSHA 10-hour building, highway and utility course, but in more depth. Participants who successfully complete the course will receive a wallet-size card.

Steel Erection Safety Awareness Training

This three-hour course, designed to educate participants on the new steel erection standard, is intended for steel erection contractors erecting steel structures such as buildings and bridges and general contractors overseeing the steel erection process. This course addresses the scope of the standard, new definitions, assembly, fall protection, connecting, decking and required documentation. Participants will receive a certificate of course completion.

Scaffold Safety Competent Person Training

This three-hour course is designed to provide training for an individual so that an employer may designate this individual to be a "competent person." It is intended for safety directors, superintendents, line foremen and field personnel, and will cover OSHA scaffolding regulations and how to set up and inspect scaffolding. Participants will receive a certificate of course completion.

Trenching and Excavation Competent Person Training

Designed to provide training for an individual so that an employer may designate this individual to be a "Competent Person," this three-hour course for safety directors, line foremen and field personnel covers the Excavation Standard – Subpart P, compliance with and general requirements of 29 CFR 1926.651, as well as hazard recognition, utility locates and use and application of protective systems. Participants will receive a certificate of course completion, a participant manual and sample record keeping documentation at the conclusion of the course.
