

## Course Description:

Math 6 has been designed according to the content required by the Common Core State Standards. Throughout the year, students will grow in their understanding of the following content areas:

- The Number System: multiplying \& dividing fractions, operations with decimals, \& order of operations
- Ratios and Proportional Relationships: ratios, rates, and percents
- Expressions and Equations: expressions, equations and inequalities
- Geometry: area and volume
- Statistics and Probability: data collection, box plots and histograms

Required materials: multiple pencils, paper, graph paper, highlighter, spiral notebook, red pen
