Applications must be received by Monday, March 25, 2013.

To apply, submit a completed, signed application and answers to the essay questions enclosed.

A letter of recommendation from a mentor or teacher must accompany your application.

You will also be asked to participate in a personal interview with the selection committee. Interview dates and times are to be determined. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.

We encourage students interested in science to apply, especially those who would be the first to attend college in their family and those from diverse communities.
