Seminole Stix Bass Club.**

1 out of every 5 boats will be paid.

**Seminole Division - Teams may fish anywhere on the Flint River,
with the cut-off being "the cut" from Jack's to Spring Creek.
Teams may not fish below the cut-off or travel across to
Spring Creek.**

Jackson Division – Teams may fish anywhere accessible by boat.

RULES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

\$55.00 Entry Fee Per Boat, Big Fish Included

- Cash Only, No Pre-paying (Registration begins at 5:30pm Eastern Time on the designated dates/locations for each division – Jackson (Sunset Landing) & Seminole (Boat Basin).
- Maximum Of Two Anglers Per Boat (you may fish alone)
- No Membership Dues
- 20% Of The Total Entry Fees Will Go to the Seminole Stix
- 100% Of The Remaining Proceeds Will Be Paid Back At The Tournament
- 1 out of every 5 boats will be paid
- 3 Fish Limit Per Boat (Largemouth, Smallmouth, Spotted, and Shoal Bass only)
- 12 Inch Size Limit
- Only Artificial Lures May Be Used (No Trolling)
- You Must Launch Your Boat At The Specified Tournament Launch Site To Be Eligible To Fish The Tournament
- Tournaments Will Begin At 6:30pm every Thursday and end at 9:30 pm
- 1 Pound Will Be Deducted Per Minute Late To Weigh-In
- ¼ Pound (0.25lbs) Will Be Deducted Per Dead Fish
- No Hole Sitting
- If An Illegal Fish Is Brought To The Scales You Will Lose The Fish Plus your largest fish
- Must Be At Least 18 Years Old Or Accompanied By An Adult To Fish
(All State Laws set forth by the state of Georgia and Florida Must Be Followed)
(No alcoholic beverages are to be consumed during the tournament time on the water)
- There will be a total of 8 tournaments for each division throughout the summer. Points will be awarded as follows: 1st place – 100 pts, 2nd place 99, 3rd place 98, and so on. Your lowest tournament will be dropped at the end of the year to determine who wins the team of the year award. (The top 10 teams from each division in points will qualify for classic)
- You must designate a Boat Captain at the first tournament and that Captain will be awarded the points for the team. The Captain may fish each event with whoever he wishes. There will be no double points awarded, only the captain of the boat receives the points for the team.
- The team of the year, as determined by points, will receive free entries for all tournaments in their division for the following year.
- Polygraphs will be used throughout the year.
- By signing this form, you release the Seminole Stix for being liable for any accidents or mishaps that occur on the water during the tournament hours.
