

How to Join?

Fill out the Membership Application request form and pay the applicable fees, it's as easy as that.

All applications are subject to approval from the Committee (allow up to 5 weeks processing time).

2016 Season

Joining Fee:

Adult (plus annual fee below) **\$100**

Children - no joining fee applies (annual fee as below)

Annual Fee:

Adult (plus joining fee above) **\$150**

Postage option to receive printed monthly newsletter **\$10** per address (free for email newsletter sent in pdf format)

Children and Youth 'Junior' (under 18*) **\$35**

* age taken as at 1 Jan 2016

Family – One or more adult/s with one or more children. Joining fee per adult (above) plus 1st adult pays half of the Adult rate; 2nd adult pays full Adult rate; 1st & 2nd child pay the child rate; 3rd and subsequent children no fee applies.

Other categories:

Associate – members may elect to transfer from Adult to Associate (eg if they are travelling overseas). You stay on the mailing list but no discounts apply for lift / accommodation. Fee applies \$35

Veteran – 25 years of continuous adult membership entitles you to a reduced annual subscription.

Fee applies \$50

Locker for boots or skis (supply your own padlock, limited number available – please check) **\$20 each**

Season lift season pass

Adult \$399, Youth* (aged 11 to 17, as at 1 Jan 2016) \$199.
*Children under 11 years ski for free. SPECIAL FREE Season Pass if you complete 6 approved Work Days & have your application form in by 22 May 2016. Can't do 6 days? – then you'll be able to purchase with a mix of work party days & cash. Application forms are sent out with the April members email & printed newsletters.

Work Days

Further discounts are available on lift fees with season passes, daily rates, accommodation and ski packages for members who choose to complete Work Days during the summer. Each Day earns a credit equivalent to the member's day lift pass, which can be traded towards accommodation or package deals.

Everyone can participate – whether you're a skilled tradesperson, a DIY handyman, or neither. There are plenty of jobs for all skill levels on the ski area in summer & at the workshop in Rangiora, as well as a range of year-round jobs that can be done in the city or from home. There's huge satisfaction to be gained from helping out on projects that assist the ski club to operate smoothly. You also have a chance to meet other members and make new friends. Work party details are published in summer in the club newsletters and e-bulletins. Work Days can be done while you're still considering membership or your application is pending – details are still captured. If you complete too many Work Days for your own use these may be used by others - special conditions apply.

Work dates remaining for this summer/autumn:

Feb 20-21; 5-6 March; 19-20 March; 28 March (Easter); plus April and May to be advised including possible promo work at the annual Ski Sale.

Summer is also a great time to be up at BR – lovely sunny weather and long, warm days. Members doing Work Days on the field bring all their own food with shared dinner and breakfast meals.
