Charlie A. Gray Jr. High School 2015 Spring Semester Exam Schedule & Protocol Monday, May 18th – Wednesday, May 20th, 2015

An "open campus" format will be used during finals and students with completed Early Release forms will be allowed to leave on Tuesday, May 19th and Wednesday, May 20th at the end of the period for which they have a final exam. Thursday, May 21st is a regular school day. Students may make-up any missed final exams on this day.

- ALL students MUST attend school the entire day on Friday, May 15th and Monday, May 18th.
- Exemptions must be handled according to the policy listed on page 16 of the Student Handbook.
- Exemption Forms should be distributed to students on Monday, May 11th. Do not inform students of exemptions prior to this date. The student should obtain the <u>teacher's</u> <u>signature first</u> and then request the parent's signature.
- Students are to give their completed **Exemption Forms** to their grade-level guidance counselor by the end of the day on **Wednesday**, **May 13th**. 8th grade to **Mrs**. **Heidleberg's office (Room 302-A)** and 9th grade to **Mrs**. **Nobles's office (Room 506)**.
- Students must have Early Release Forms turned in to their 7th period teacher by Wednesday, May 13th.
- Teachers are to place the Early Release Forms in a folder and turn them in to Mrs. Blaylock on Thursday, May 14th by 11:00 a.m.
- Students who submit an Early Release form will not be allowed to return to campus for any reason including riding the bus home.
- If students are at school they are expected to be IN CLASS. "Hanging out" in the media center, gym, or elsewhere will not be permitted.
- Students who do not have a ride home and must remain at school until the buses run will be required to follow the class schedule indicated below. For example: On Tuesday, students who do not have a ride home and who have a 1st period final, but exempt their 2nd period final, and have a 3rd period final will be required to attend that 2nd period class; however, they are not to be made to take the final if they can exempt. Teachers will not penalize a student for not having a ride home.
