What is the largest animal that lives on land? You most likely said, "The elephant." You are correct. (In the animal kingdom, only the whale is larger.) There are two kinds of elephants. First is the African elephant. The second is the Asian or Indian elephant. They are related. But they look different. The African elephant is bigger. Its ears are about four feet wide. Its tusks are about six to eight feet long. Our interest is with the African elephant.

An African male is about 11 1/2 feet at the shoulder. It weighs from 12,000 to 14,000 pounds. The largest ever measured stood 13 feet and 2 inches tall.

The elephant has thick skin. It's about one inch thick. It's heavy. The skin alone weighs about a ton. Yet it is <u>tender</u>. The bite of a horsefly will draw blood. Elephants like to smear mud and clay over themselves. This protects their skin from bites by flies.

The elephant's trunk is about six feet long. It weighs about 300 __17__. The elephant uses the trunk in many ways. It smells, drinks, and feeds itself with its trunk.

The tusks (about six feet long) are really teeth. Only two thirds of each tusk sticks out. The rest is in the skull. Tusks are used to dig for food. They are also 18 used to fight. When trained, elephants can lift as much as a ton with their tusks. The molars (the grinding teeth) are about a foot long. Elephants have four molars. Each weights eight to nine pounds. The mother elephant gives birth after 20 to 22 months. At birth, the baby weighs about 200 pounds. It is already about three feet tall.
