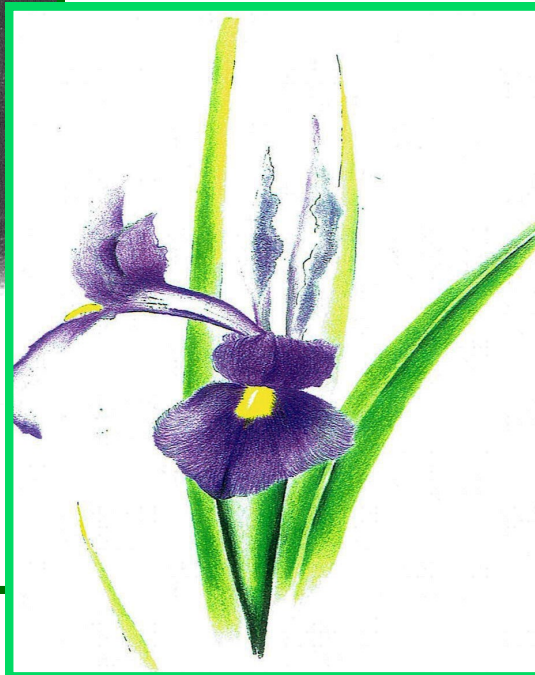
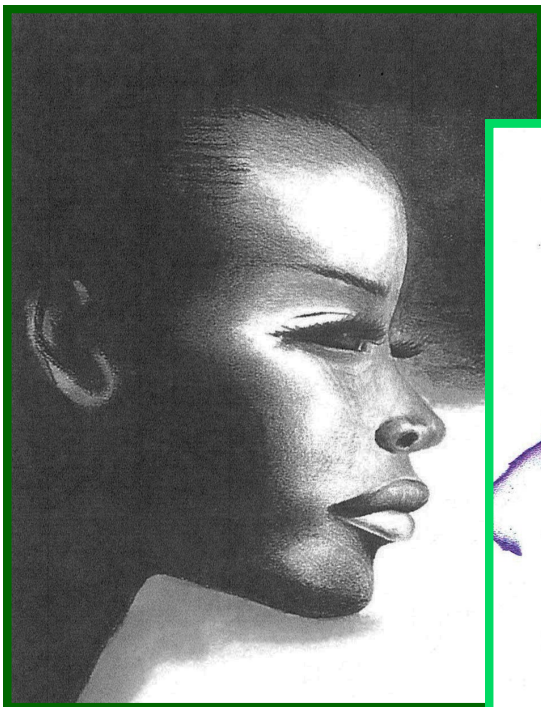

### **Senior Art Contest in March**

The Oak Park Senior Center wishes to extend a personal invitation to their fourth Annual Art Show and optional sale (artists are responsible for their own sales). **Applications and entry fee will be accepted** at this time. Art will be accepted **Thursday and Friday, March 19 and 20 from 9am to 3pm**. Due to the tremendous response from last year, you are urged to respond early because there is limited space. The final showing will be held on Friday, March 27, 10am, including lunch, music, awards and reception. Following the reception all art should be retrieved. There is no protective storage space available at the park.

Entry fee is \$15 for one entry, \$17 for two, \$19 for three. Each participant will be limited to three submissions.

The contest is open to all seniors of San Joaquin County over the age of 50. There will be five categories for awards: Oil, Acrylic, Watercolor, Other and Pro (this category will have only one prize of \$100). The first four categories will have prizes of \$100 first place, \$50 second place and \$30 third place.
