**Open Afternoon** all parents and carers are invited to attend an open afternoon when they can observe their children in the class situation and view some of the work undertaken this session. However, please note that this is not a time for discussing individual children or their progress.

**Sports Day** – it is planned to have a full day of Sports activities on **Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> June**. The morning – from 10.00 -12.00 will be spent participating in "Potted Sports" activities, followed by an early lunch from 12.00-1.00 and class races in the afternoon at 1.30-3.00. It is planned to have the "Potted Sports" on the field behind Glen Urquhart High School and the races on the Astroturf. These plans are, of course, weather permitting!

**Swimming** – P6/7 start their swimming lessons at Inverness Aquadome on **Friday** 29<sup>th</sup> April.

Parent Council – the next meeting of the Parent Council is planned for **Thursday** 28<sup>th</sup> April at 7.00 pm in the school.

**Indoor Shoes** - pupils are all asked to bring a pair of indoor shoes to wear in class. This is particularly important during times when the playground is wet and muddy as changing from outdoor to indoor shoes helps keep the school floors clean. Pupils are asked to take their indoor shoes home at the end of every term so that parents and carers are able to replace these shoes as and when necessary. It is noted that a number of senior pupils do not have indoor shoes at present. Please check that your child has indoor shoes and that they are not needing to be replaced.

Lateness – Although there has been a general improvement in pupils arriving in school on time, there are a small number of pupils who are still persistently late. Please note that the name of pupils who arrive late is noted, along with their arrival time and the reason for lateness in the school "Late Book". Parents are asked to make an effort to ensure that their children arrive in school on time as late arrivals are disruptive to learning and teaching in classes.

**Absences** - Apart from illness, absence from school should be kept to a minimum and parents/carers should not take a child away from school for holidays or social purposes. Any unnecessary absences should be avoided. When a pupil's attendance record falls below **80%**, it is considered a cause for concern. It may be necessary to inform parents of pupils whose attendance is at this level so that they are aware that their child's absence record is a cause for concern. All parents are asked to telephone the school office before **9.00am** on each day of absence, to notify us of the reason for absence
