WHEREAS it is expedient to close and declare surplus that Part of Lot 6, Concession 4, former Township of Monck, now Town of Bracebridge, District Municipality of Muskoka, designated as Part 1 on Plan 35R-23597, and to transfer the soil and freehold of it, pursuant to Sections 9 and 35 of the Municipal Act, 2001;

BY-LAW NO. 2013 -

A BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF BRACEBRIDGE TO AMEND BY-LAW 2006-120, A LAND USE CONTROL BY-LAW TO REGULATE THE USE OF LAND IN THE TOWN OF BRACEBRIDGE

WHEREAS By-law No. 2006-120 was enacted to regulate land use in Muskoka North Ward, of the Town of Bracebridge, in the District Municipality of Muskoka.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to amend the said by-laws by rezoning certain lands and by the addition of certain provisions;

AND WHEREAS by motion 13-DS-019 the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Bracebridge deems it expedient to pass such a by-law;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF BRACEBRIDGE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That Schedule "B" to By-law No. 2006-120 is hereby amended by changing the zoning of Part of Lots 1 and 2, Concession 12, Muskoka North Ward of the Town of Bracebridge, being Part of Part 1 on Plans 35R-3228 and 35R-3731 and Parts 10 and 11 of Plan 35R-16089 from the present zones of Business Park Industrial (M1) to Business Park Industrial Special 11 (M1-11), which lands are more particularly shown outlined in red on Schedule "A" attached hereto.
- 2. That Section 7.1.3: Industrial Zones Exceptions is hereby amended by the addition of the following:
 - Zone Permitted Uses
 - M1-11 In a Business Park Industrial Special 11 (M1-11) Zone, the permitted uses are all those uses in the Business Park Industrial (M1) Zone including Financial Services Establishment.

All other applicable provisions of the Business Park Industrial (M1) Zone shall continue to apply in respect to the lands located within the Business Park Industrial Special - 11 (M1-11) Zone.

- 3. That Schedule "A" attached hereto forms part of this by-law.
- 4. That this By-law shall take effect on the date of passage by Council and shall come into force in accordance with Section 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O., 1990.

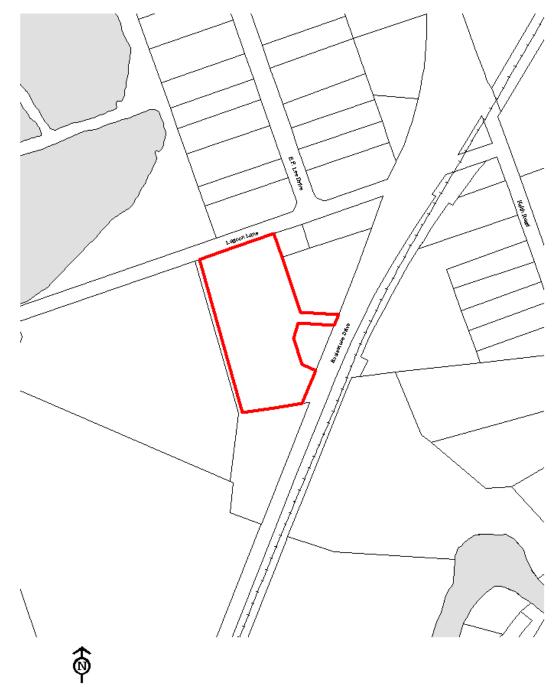
