## Workshop/Seminar Report

#### September:

Ann Card will be teaching a piece with a sunflower on a background done using webbing. It is really pretty and something different. It is the usual \$15 workshop fee plus a supply fee of \$10.

#### October:

Mary will be taking orders for the surface for this workshop. This will be an original design so we should feel pretty special to be the first ones to do this project. It is the usual \$15 workshop fee plus a supply fee of \$10.

#### November:

This is a great opportunity to get our name out to the community and raise funds to help cover our chapter's expenses.

We will be doing the art show in November. The dates are November 15th and 16th, 10 am to 5pm. Pieces for the booth can be donated to the chapter to sell and proceeds to the chapter or sold on a commission basis. There will be a sign up sheet at the meetings prior to and including the October meeting to commit to a block of time. We will also need help with set up and take down. If you sign up to work a shift either one of the two days your commission fee will be 10%. If you are unable to attend the show, the commission fee will be 20%. We will also be asking folks to demo. We are asking all pieces to be in to the chapter by the October meeting. There will be guidelines for labeling and packing in the newsletters as the time approaches.

### **Supply List for September Workshop**

First of all, let's all hope and pray for a sunny day, but just in case of rain, a hair dryer would be a good thing.

The surface we will be working on is 16 x 20 so please bring an old towel to put under your surface as we may get it wet or get paint on it, and we will keep the tables unstained.

Water color brushes: a fairly large flat, maybe a 16, and a round 8. If you don't have these sizes, don't go out and buy any unless you want them anyway. Any larger flat will work for the background and the round for the sunflower petals. If you only have acrylic brushes, they will be fine.

Painter tape, frog tape, etc. in a width of at least one inch. I do not recommend regular masking tape because it might lift your background. (If you don't have tape, don't go out and buy it. I will bring some.)

Paper Towels

Watercolor palette (if you don't have one, just pick up one of those round inexpensive ones at Michaels or Hobby Lobby. I think they are under \$2.00.

A water bucket with two wells - one for cleaning your brushes and one for clean water for your board.

Transfer paper, I believe white or grey will work, a piece of tracing paper, and a stylus.



The business meeting starts at 10:00 am and is followed by a painting program/workshop. We generally "brown bag" our lunch with drinks and a dessert provided by different members.




