INTRODUCTION

THE LEAGUE

In 2012 the league was formed by six women who all reside in the City of Kawartha Lakes. The goal was to establish a competitive roller derby league following the Women's Flat Track Derby Association (WFTDA) rules and regulations in terms of training, testing and establishing a postive sport culture.

Lindsay Roller Derby Objectives:

- 1. To promote the sport of Roller Derby in the Lindsay area and throughout Canada.
- 2. To promote the importance of Roller Derby safety, standards, and athleticism.
- 3. To provide a positive and supportive environment for its members.
- 4. To encourage members to pursue their athletic and leadership potentials.
- 5. To promote teamwork, cooperation, camaraderie and good will amongst its members and with the larger Roller Derby community.
- 6. To promote health and endurance through safe skating practices.
- 7. To encourage members to have a hand in running the league.
- 8. To organize and manage family friendly bouts locally for its own teams as well as with other leagues or teams.
- 9. To provide a travel team to play bouts against other teams or leagues in other locations.
- 10. To become and operate as a non-profit corporation in a professional manner, abiding by all local and national laws and regulations.
- 11. To make charitable contributions of time, goods, or money to other non-profit organizations as deemed appropriate by the league.

A full Executive Committee was elected at the 2012 AGM with a new co-presidency role established to ensure fairness and diversity in all of our decisions. Lindsay Roller Derby's full Executive Committee consists of seven voting members.

The Lindsay Roller Derby League is run by its skaters, for its skaters. We are committed to providing a fun and enthusiastic atmosphere that promotes team-work and co-operation through derby sisterhood. We believe in encouraging vigorous and exuberant healthy living, as well as giving back to our communities.

In November of 2012, Lindsay Roller Derby hosted the Red & Green Scrimmage. Participants and spectators were required to bring a non-perishable food item to gain entry to the event, and players from as far as London, Ontario arrived in Lindsay to participate. The Executive Committee also participated in the Big Brothers & Big Sisters bowling event to raise money for the organization.

The continuation of our ability to secure practice and bout venues within the Kawartha Lakes area in the fall and winter months will be a contributing factor in our ability to attract more quality players to our league and also help with retaining our existing reputation as a league that openly welcomes skaters from all areas of Ontario to join our practices and participate in all of our events.

The league looks to progress further in 2014 with the ongoing support of all our players, coaches, supporters and most importantly, our sponsors. The progress in the results of our teams will be watched with interest as the sport of women's flat track roller derby continues to grow in Ontario at an exponential rate.
