#### Context

Adults will be assessed using the benchmark report for having a dose or doses of HPV. Progress towards reaching 90% will be measured using a WIR benchmark report. Only adults who have moved out of the agency's jurisdiction may be removed from the cohort for analysis. Unless you can prove that an adult has moved out of your jurisdiction, you cannot remove them from your cohort

Guidelines for determining increase needed for progress toward contract cycle goals:

20%-29% - 8% above baseline

30%-39% - 7% above baseline

40%-49% - 6% above baseline

50%-59% - 5% above baseline

60%-69% - 4% above baseline
