Sprint cars are high-powered 700-900 hp race cars designed primarily for the purpose of running on short oval, circular dirt or paved tracks. Sprint car racing is popular in the United States, Canada, Australia, New Zealand and South Africa.

# 2003 - 2007 | Ministock Car 55H

Ministocks are a class of car raced at many New Zealand speedway tracks. Ministocks are primarily youth grade however at some tracks they are raced as an adult class.

Ministocks are not currently a 'recognized' class in New Zealand; this means they are not able to run big championships in the North, South, and New Zealand Championships. In the youth grade drivers are aged 12 - 16 and are taught to focus on how to handle a car on the racing track and learn racing rules as well as various sorts of tactics.





My first car, Dad and I built this car from scratch. We not only had a great time doing it, I also enjoyed my introduction to racing. My knowledge and training continued to fuel my passion for motor racing and my successes led me to strive harder and push myself further.

I had several wins in this class including being the two time winner of the Young Achievers Award (an invitation only event for the top drivers from each track) as well as winning the Waikato and Auckland Champs on several occasions.

I was also invited to race in the international series V Australia – In which our NZ team won.
