Although we have been here since the beginning of the subdivision in the 1960's, some people in the community do not realize that this is your club. Everyone in the community is welcome to join! We realize that in these tough economic times, it is not easy to find affordable family recreation. This is why we purposely keep the fees to a minimum so that membership is affordable for our residents. Thanks to the cooperation of the Shaughnessy P.S. and the Jump-Start Program, over the past four years we have sponsored many children in our community. This has enabled them to take tennis lessons, receive a season-long membership and a tennis racquet. We plan to continue this policy for the coming season and seasons beyond. If affordability is an issue, please do not hesitate to speak to Ian Turner, the Principal at Shaughnessy P.S. All discussion is in strictest confidence and no one beyond lan and the President of the tennis club will know who is sponsored. Adult (\$70), Family (\$140) and Junior (\$25) Memberships are available and the season begins on April 25th and continues until the middle of October.

**TOONIE PROGRAM**: A full description is included on the following pages, but it should be said that this afterschool program, is terrific for 4, 5 and 6 year old kids. At \$2 for an hour-long session, it really hits the mark. The great thing is, that you only pay for the lessons your child attends! Just bring a Toonie along each day.

**JUNIORS**: (7 - 18 years old or up to 25 years of age if a full time student \$25)

In April, we will place a Tennis Professional in Shaughnessy P.S. for 4-5 days to teach tennis in the Physical Education Program. As well, in May and June we will offer an extensive after-school program (outlined on the last page of the newsletter). Our tennis professional, Ed Wilson, and his staff, run a very reasonably priced program. Each session is 90 minutes long and runs after school from 4:30-6:00 p.m. The cost works out to \$5.00 per hour! Where else can you receive this value?

With our large junior membership we have been able to run two competitive teams in the NYTA Junior League. Last year we finished 1st and 2nd.

**ADULTS:** Whether you're a beginner or a more experienced player, we have much to offer. Beginning in May, we offer three, free 2 hour clinics to all adult members. Come to the Drop-In Nights, the Round Robins, the Club Tournaments, or join the competitive teams. We have an Inter-county C Team, a Mixed Veterans Team, and a Ladies A team. You may just wish to enjoy casual play with a friend, the choice is yours. Play as often as you wish, during the day or under the lights as late as 11:00 p.m.

I hope that we can convince you to join your community tennis club. Last season, 310 of your friends and neighbours made the choice to participate in this enjoyable outdoor activity for themselves, their children or their family. Why not you?

### Exciting 2009 Spring Programs

### **Toonie Tennis - Ages 4, 5 and 6 years** 4:30 – 5:30 Mondays and Wednesdays

This program features smaller nets, courts and special balls. Drills, small group instruction and play are used in each session. Racquets are provided. The emphasis is on fun, skill development and playing. In addition to the 15 lessons, 1 special event will be held on a Saturday afternoon. The program starts May 4 and ends June 24 (no lessons on May 18, June 15 or 17, but replaced by Friday May 22 & June 5. (Tax receipt for child's lessons issued upon request)

#### Junior Programs - Ages 7 and over 4:30 - 6:00 each day

These programs use regular tennis equipment and concentrate on skill development, fun and competition. Small group instruction, drills and play are part of each session. One special event will be held on a Saturday afternoon. In the event of rain, Friday of the same week will be used as a make-up day.
