Improved Immune systems may be in the cards

Berkeley. Feeling weary? A biologist says playing bridge may be good for the immune system. Marian Cleeves Diamond, a professor at UC Berkeley, recently presented research showing that an area of the brain involved in playing bridge stimulates the immune system. She found that playing bridge stimulates the thymus gland – which produces white blood cells that patrol the body in search of viruses and other invaders. It is the first time a specific area of the brain's cortex has been linked with the immune system.
