Please note: Vision Benefits information and providers are only available on the www.uhcvision.com website. *Medical care related information and providers including eye specialists/surgeons* is found on UnitedHealthcare's medical care website www.myuhc.com.

We want to bring to your attention that when accessing Vision Benefits information and providers at the www.uhcvision.com website, or by calling 1-800-638-3120, it is important to note that the **Vision Benefits member identification number for all members on the same plan is the social security number of the primary member (the City of Tampa employee)**. This is different from the member identification number on your UnitedHealthcare medical plan card, which is for *medical care only* (not Vision Benefits).

To obtain a list of available providers, access the Vision Benefits website (www.uhcvision.com) and enter your designated zip code. Once you select a Vision Benefits provider from the list, you may contact the provider to schedule your one routine eye exam per year that you are entitled to as part of UnitedHealthcare's Vision Benefits program.

When scheduling an appointment, please identify yourself as a member of UnitedHealthcare's "**Vision Discount Program**" – not the UnitedHealthcare *medical plan*. You may be asked to provide your Vision Benefits member identification number, which as stated above, is the social security number of the UnitedHealthcare *primary member* (City of Tampa employee).

We hope that the above information is helpful. Please see the reverse side of this letter for additional information to help walk you through accessing UnitedHealthcare's Vision Benefits website.
