MIDDLE SCHOOL FORT BEND ISD OFF-CAMPUS PHYSICAL EDUCATION GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS AND PARENTS

- Print a copy of the registration packet from the Health and PE website
 (http://www.fortbendisd.com/Page/1128) or pick up a packet from the counselors' office on your campus.
- 2. Check to see if your child's commercial establishment is included on the list on pages 5.
- 3. <u>If your commercial establishment is listed</u>, take pages 3 and 6 to the representative at your establishment. Have them complete the forms and you return it to the counselor at your school <u>no later than August 1 for the Fall Semester and December 1 for the Spring Semester.</u>
- 4. <u>If your commercial establishment is not listed</u>, take pages 3, 6, and 7 to your commercial establishment. Have them complete the forms and you return them to the counselor by <u>August 1 for the Fall Semester and December 1 for the Spring Semester</u>. The counselor will submit the forms to the Assistant Director of Athletics for approval. Because not all establishments will be approved, it is better to do this much earlier.
- 5. Approval letter as well as attendance & grade verification forms will be mailed home.
- 6. Be sure that your child's instructor understands that attendance and grade verification forms must be sent to your counselor at the end of each nine-week grading period. These forms must show days and hours of attendance and a numerical grade for that nine-week period.
- 7. Notify your child's school immediately if there is any change to your child's off campus physical education program. Students will not be allowed to change commercial establishments at any time during a semester.
- 8. Students in Category I will not be given the option of a second elective on campus and are not allowed to stay on campus for the period they are exempt from Physical Education.
- 9. Students will not be permitted to attend two commercial establishments in order to qualify for Category I and the 15 hour requirement.
- 10. Category II status is not open to middle school students.

FORT BEND I.S.D. OFF-CAMPUS PHYSICAL EDUCATION COMMISSIONER'S CRITERIA

Request for waivers for approval of private or commercially sponsored physical activity programs will be considered in two categories. These are:

CATEGORY I

A Category 1 activity is a private or commercially sponsored physical activity that leads to Olympic level participation and/or competition. These programs typically involve a minimum of 15 hours per week of highly intense, professionally supervised training. The training facility, instructors, and the activities involved in the program must be certified by the superintendent or his/her designee to be of exceptional quality.

Students participating at this level may receive a maximum of one-half credit per semester. A total of two credits may be earned toward state high school graduation requirements for students who entered the 9th grade prior to the 2011-2012 school year.

Students who enter the 9th grade in the 2011-2012 school year can earn up to four credits toward state high school graduation.

Students qualifying and participating at this level may be dismissed from school one period (approximately one hour) per day for such participation. Students dismissed must not be permitted to miss any academic class (other than physical education).

It is anticipated that only a very limited number of students will qualify for this exceptional level of participation.

<u>CATEGORY 2</u> (Waivers in Category 2 must be approved by the local board but <u>do not</u> require approval of the Texas Education Agency.)

A Category 2 activity is a private or commercially sponsored physical activity program as certified by the superintendent or his/her designee to be of high quality, well supervised by appropriately trained instructors, and consisting of a minimum of five (5) hours per week.

Students participating at this level may substitute a maximum of one-half credit per semester. A total of two credits may be earned toward state high school graduation requirements for students who entered the 9th grade prior to the 2011-2012 school year.

Students who enter the 9th grade in the 2011-2012 school year can earn up to four credits toward state high school graduation.

Students certified to participate at this level may not be dismissed from any part of the school day.

In all cases, it is the responsibility of the superintendent or his/her designee to certify both the level of participation and the quality of the program. Additionally, the district is responsible for monitoring and recording the attendance of the students involved.

Written board policies must be adopted authorizing the private or commercially sponsored physical activity programs to substitute for physical education.

FORT BEND I.S.D. OFF CAMPUS PHYSICAL EDUCATION GUIDELINES FOR COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENT

- Student applications must be completed and returned to the Registrar's Office at the home school <u>on or before August 1 for the Fall Semester and December 1 for the Spring</u> <u>Semester.</u>
- 2) Students must be enrolled for the entire semester (as described on both the student and establishment applications).
- 3) Students must be in attendance for at least the minimum required hours per week; for their approved category, for the entire semester.
- 4) Students who drop out prior to the end of the semester, will receive a grade of "fail", and the Credit Verification form will be returned to the home school immediately.
- 5) Credit Verification forms are due to the school's Registrar at the end of each Nine Weeks period.
- 6) The Fort Bend Independent School District reserves the right to issue a grade based on available information.
- 7) Student attendance records should be maintained at all times and available for inspection by a representative of Fort Bend Independent School District.
- 8) The conditions as outlined in the student's application shall be adhered to by the commercial establishment.
- 9) The student is required to attend school under the compulsory attendance laws. Students who fail to attend school on ten or more days or parts of days within a six-month period in the same school year or on three or more days or parts of days within a four-week period may be prosecuted for nonattendance. Attendance at state and national level competitions may be an exception to this rule.
