

CHANT CHARGER 2013 General Football Information

All Home Schooled boys who will be in the 6th-12th grade in the Fall of 2013 are encouraged to participate. This is COMPETITIVE football, and will be played against a group of Private, Public, Charter, and Home School Teams.

We play 6 Man Football, which while no less competitive, allows our athletes the opportunity to play in unique and different positions that they might not in the traditional 11 man game.

OUR TEAMS FOR 2013

Middle School- (grades 6-8)

Middle School Defined by the TAIAO (Our Athletic Association)-An Athlete may participate at the middle School level until such time as they turn 15 prior to September 1st of the participating year.

• Three years of Middle School eligibility.

*(6th graders will be evaluated by the coaching staff on an individual basis)

High School (grades 9-12)

High School Defined by the TAIAO- A player shall be deemed to have reached the 9th grade if they turn 15 prior to September 1st.

• Four years of High School eligibility (unless played up as a need from Middle School)

HIGH SCHOOL INFORMATION
