

HMCS Regina was recently deployed on Operation ARTEMIS. It was her second term on this operation. She spent 120 days on the Arabian Sea to protect against terrorist activity. She is currently on patrol on the Mediterranean Sea in support of NATO Forces.

HMCS Regina is a one of 12 Halifax class Frigates currently in the Royal Canadian Navy with approximately 250 crewmembers. This includes a crew in support of a Sea King helicopter and a crew for an unmanned aerial vehicle detachment. Her homeport is Esquimalt, British Columbia and she's been at sea since January 6, 2014.
