DIRECTIONS

To Compass Pointe Golf Courses

From the Baltimore beltway (I-695):

From I-695 take Arundel Expressway (Route 10 south) to Severna Park. Take Route 100 east to Gibson Island. Turn left on Magothy Bridge Road (Route 607 north), which becomes Hogneck Road. Follow to the end and turn right on Fort Smallwood Road. Travel .75 miles. Take the second right after the Compass Pointe community to the clubhouse.

From the Annapolis area:

Take Governor Ritchie Highway (Route 2 north). Turn right on Magothy Bridge Road (Route 607 north), which becomes Hogneck Road. Follow to the end and turn right on Fort Smallwood Road. Travel .75 miles. Take the second right after the Compass Pointe community to the clubhouse.

From the Washington, D.C., beltway (I-495):

From I-495 take I-95 north to Baltimore. Exit Route 100 east to Glen Burnie. Follow Route 100 east to Gibson Island. Turn left on Magothy Bridge Road (Route 607 north), which becomes Hogneck Road. Follow to the end and turn right on Fort Smallwood Road. Travel .75 miles. Take the second right after the Compass Pointe community to the clubhouse.
